






avecat Pete wakes up early. The sun is shining. The birds are singing.

Pete sees the spiked tail of his main man Skip the Stegosaurus.


"How are you feeling today, Skip?" Pete asks. Skip has been sick with the sniffles.


"Better," says Skip. "Thanks for asking."


"You up for a picnic?"

"I think so," says Skip. "I'd hate to miss the fun."











Trini comes over. "Terri is cheating at hide-and-seek. She's flying around and peeking."
