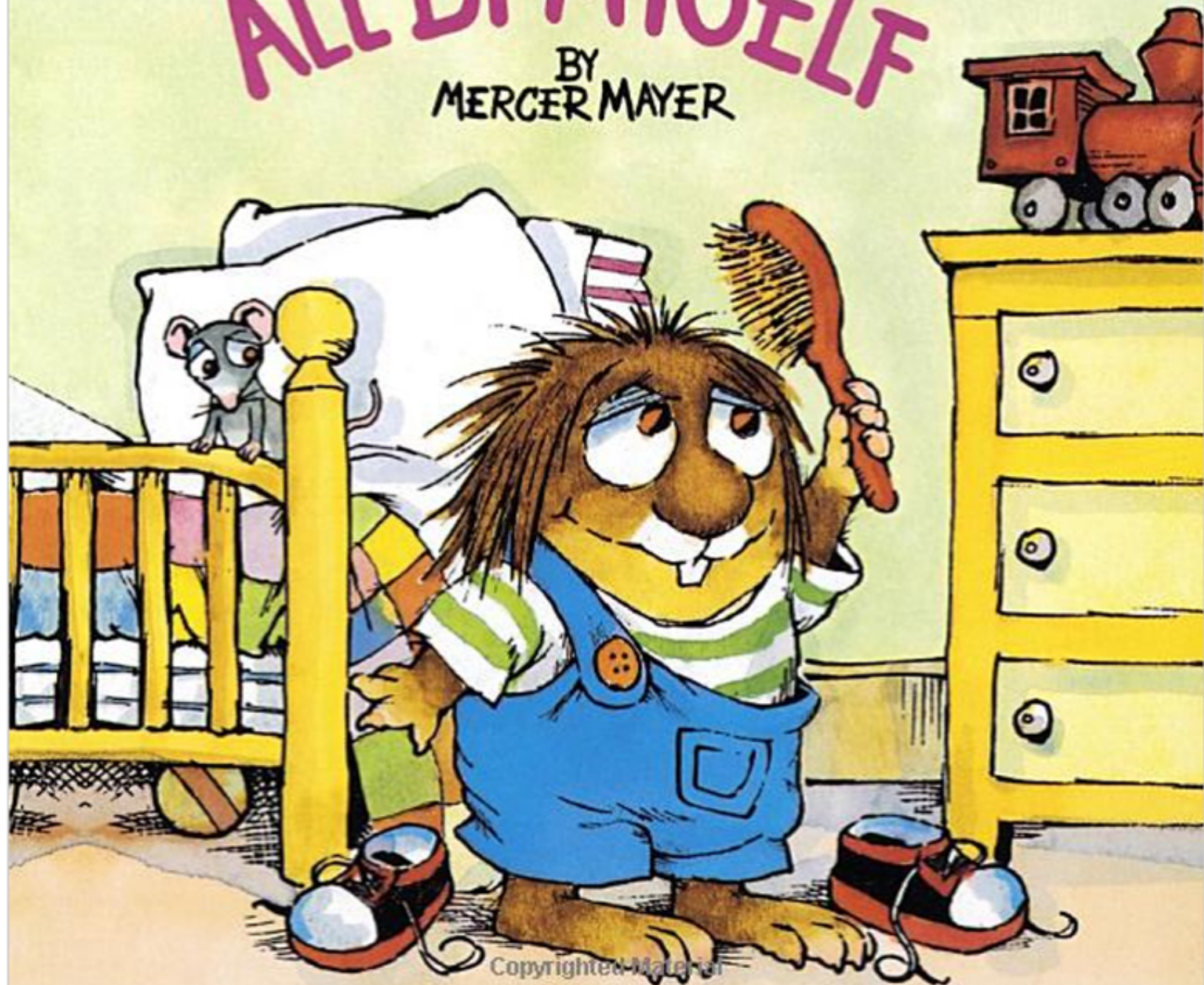

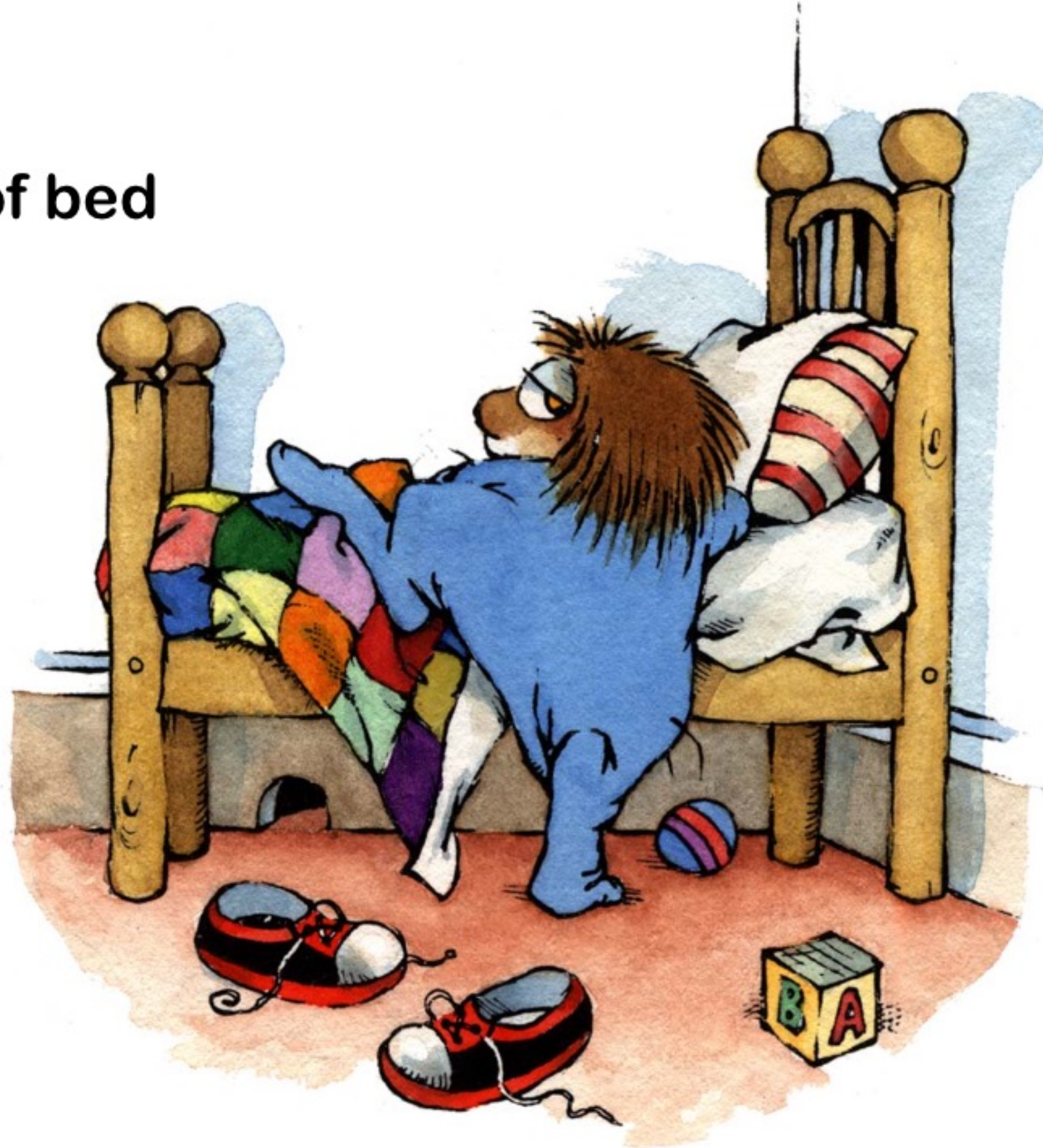

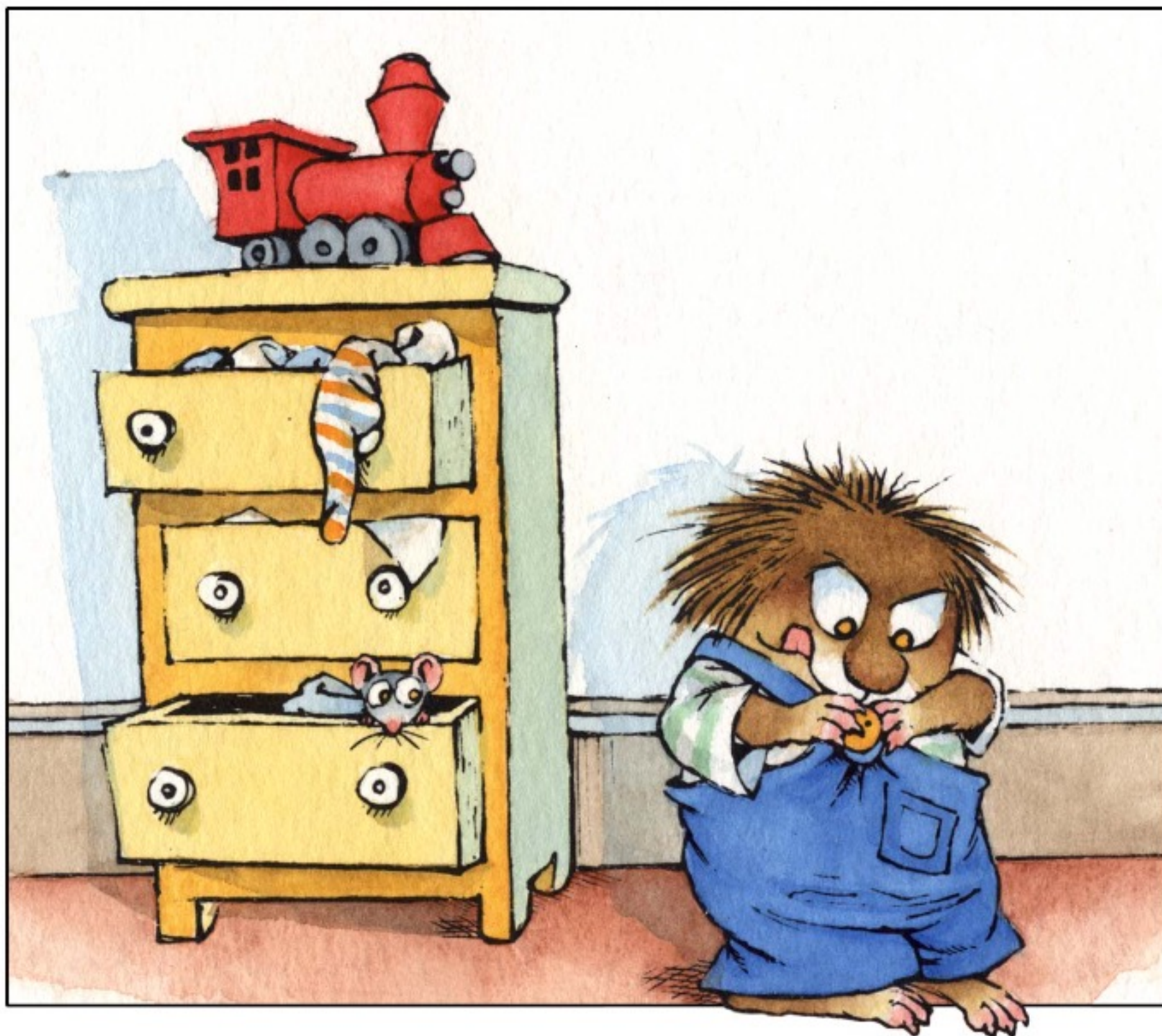

all by myself.



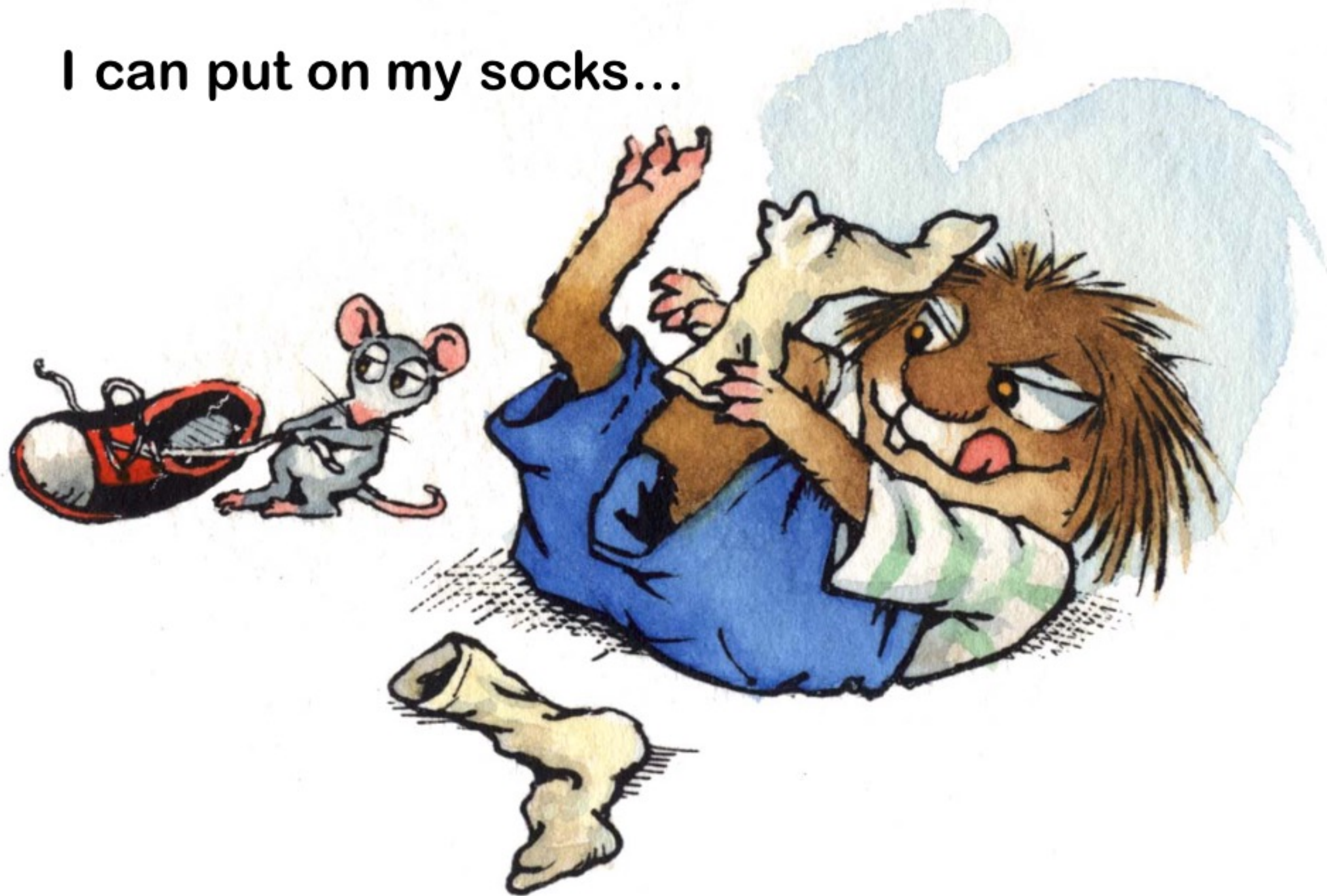

I can brush my fur.

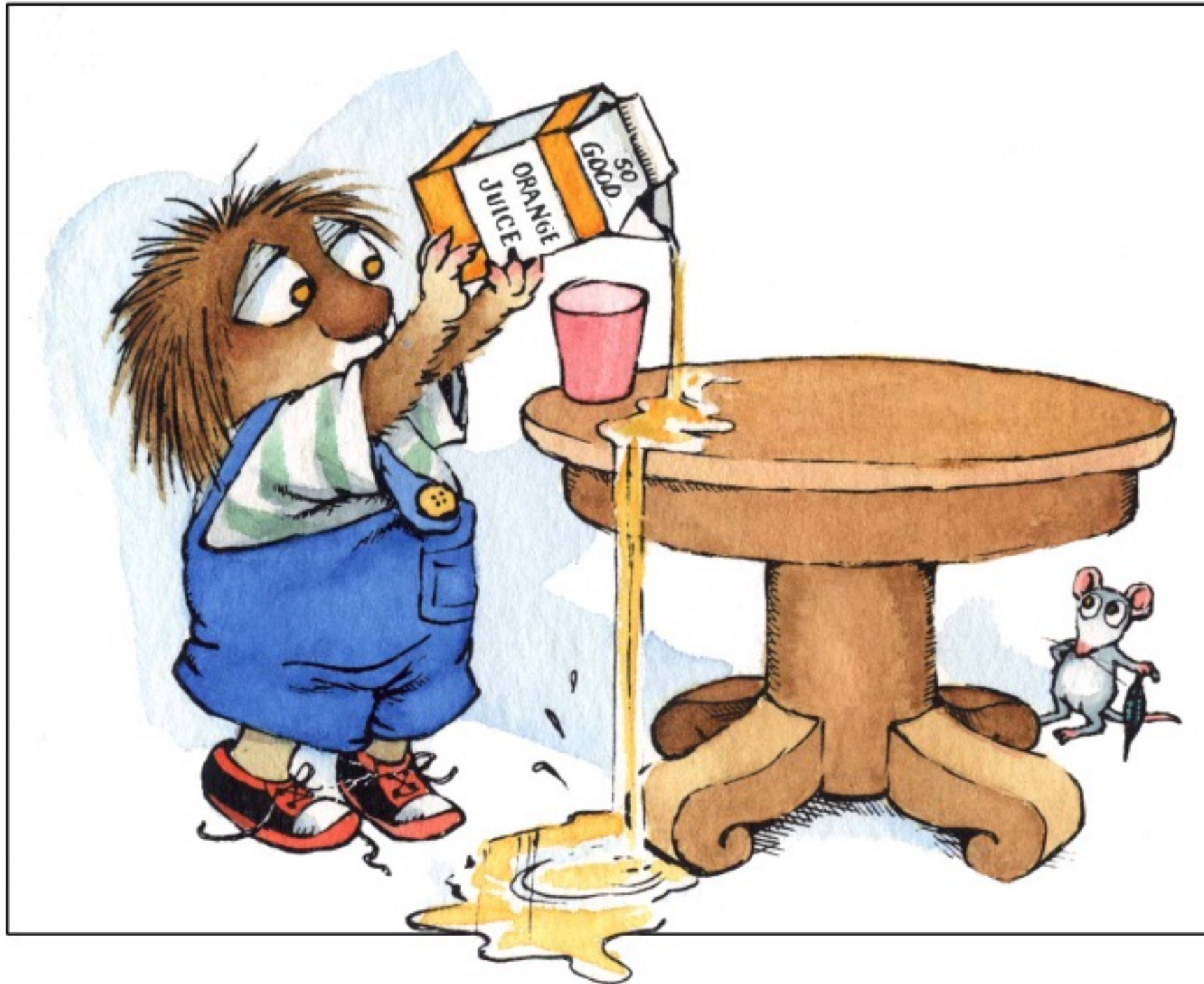
I can put on my socks...



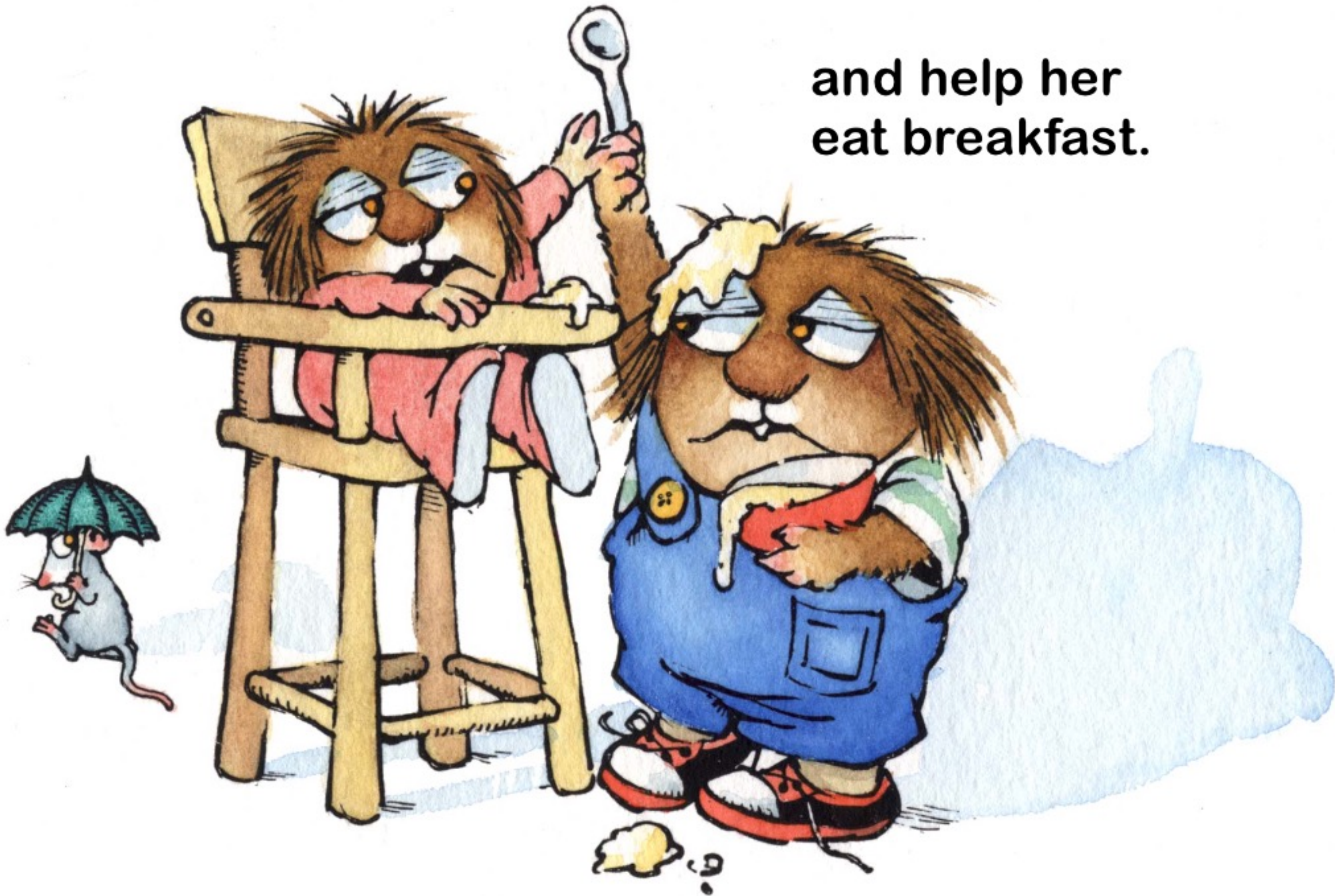
and tie my shoes.

eat breakfast.



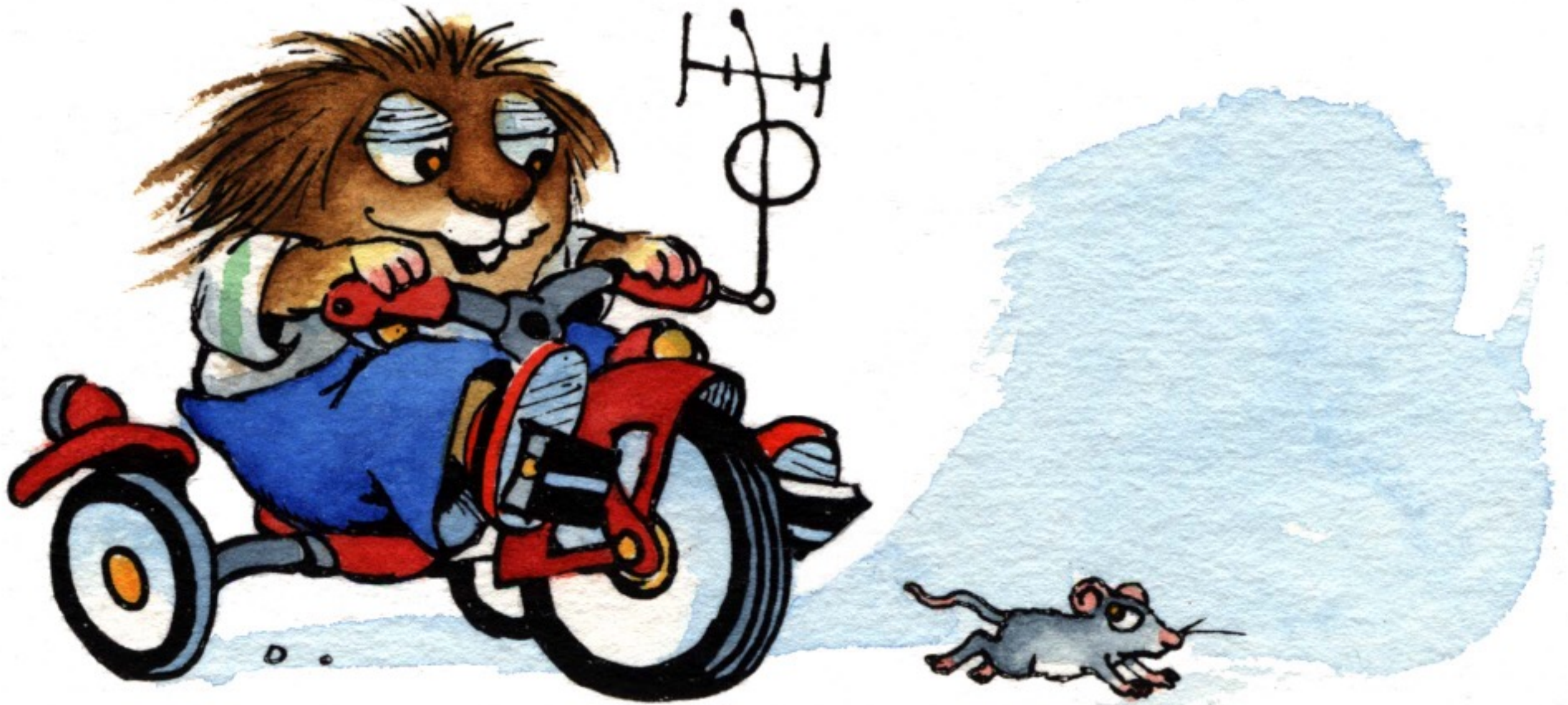
I can pull a duck for her.

I can kick my ball...



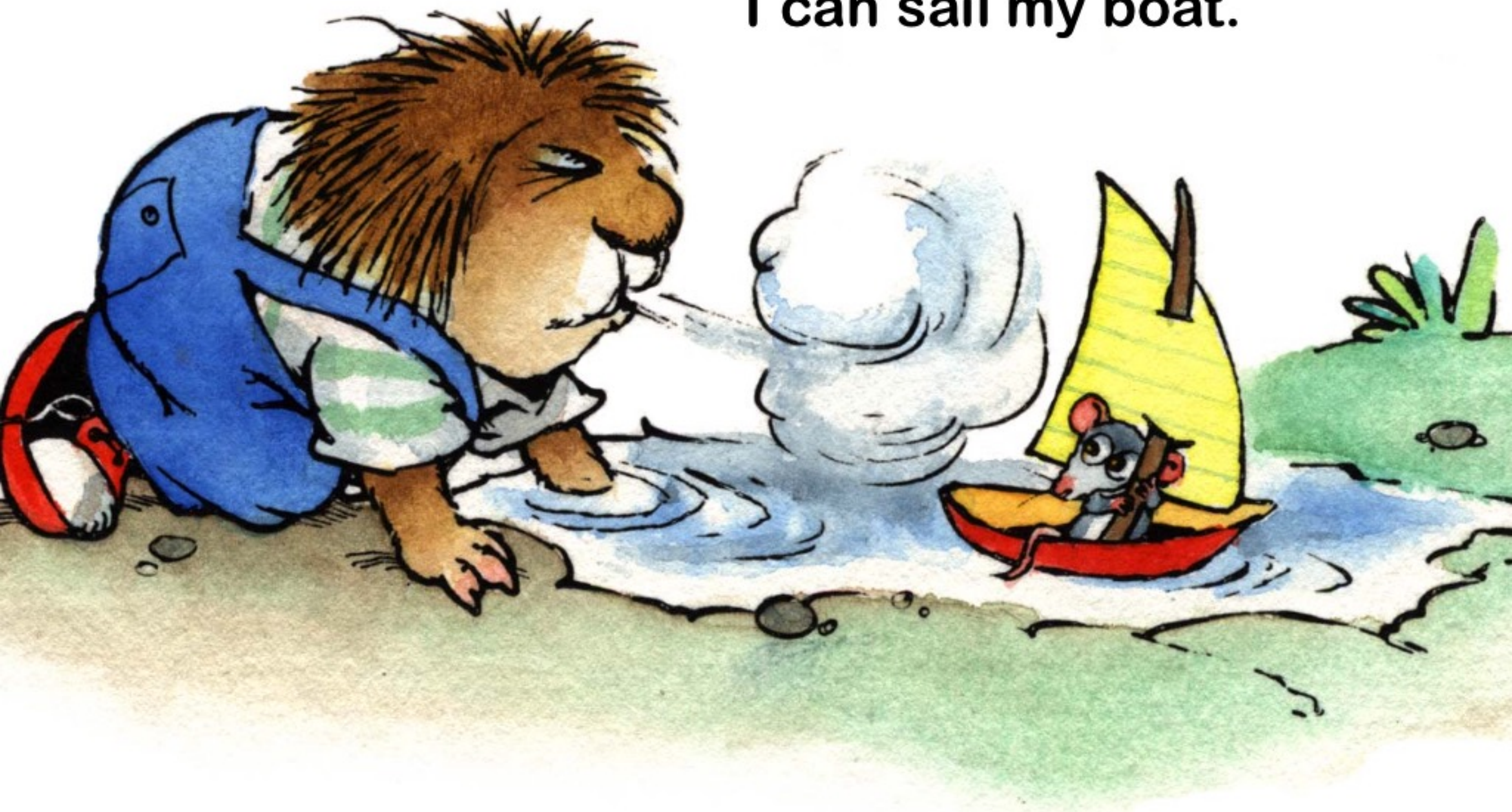

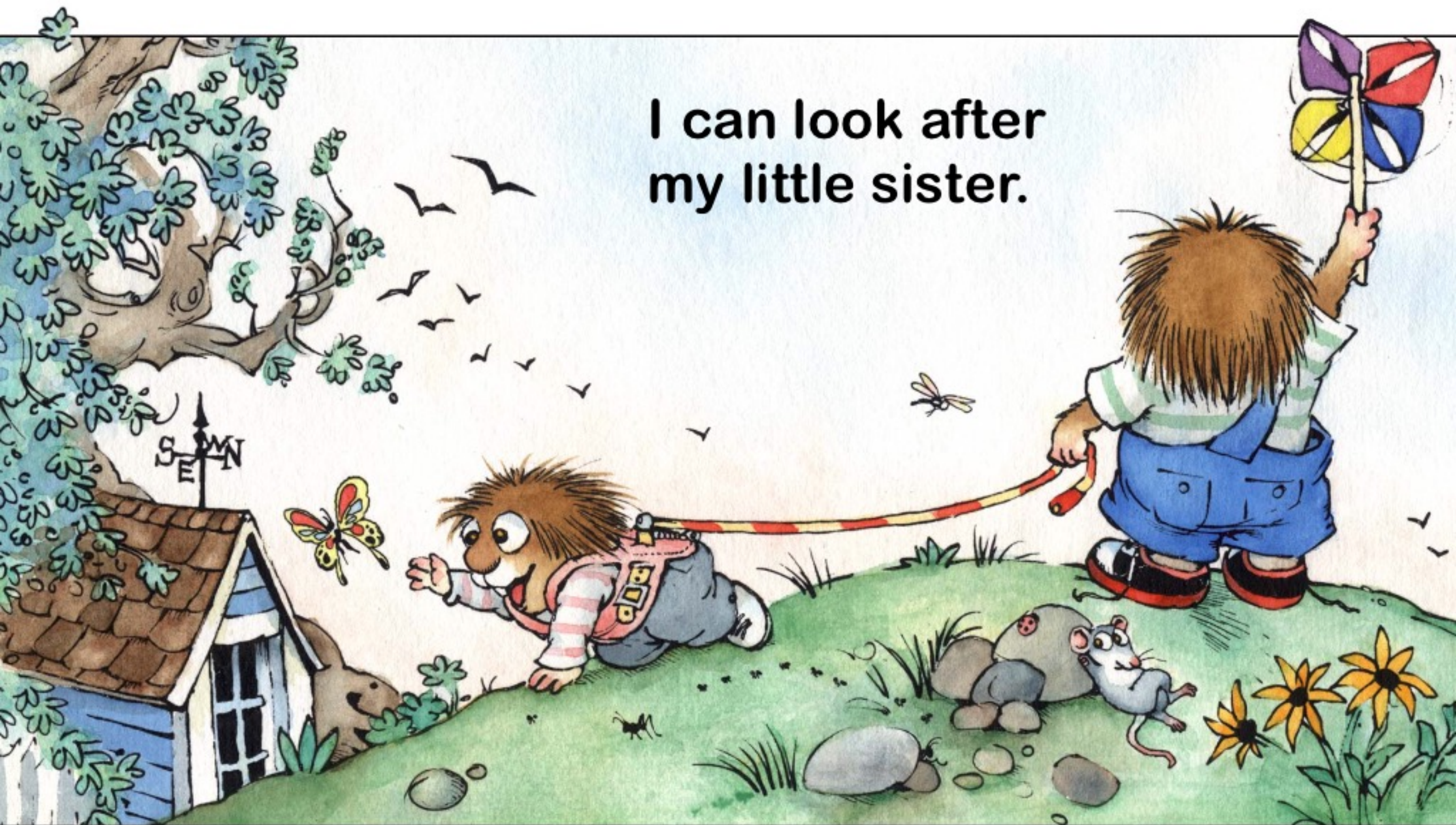

my hammer.

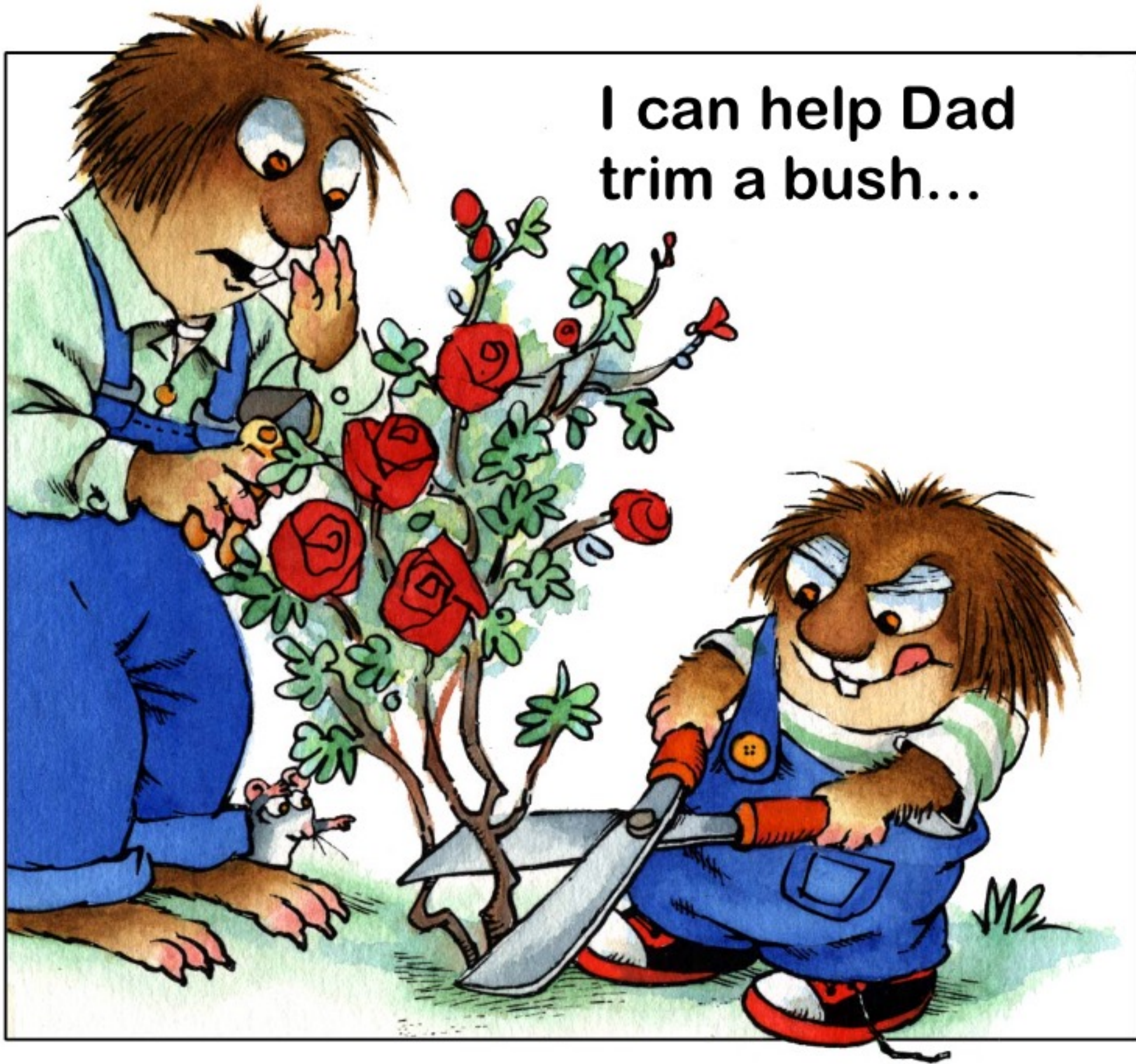
I can sail my boat.

my little sister.



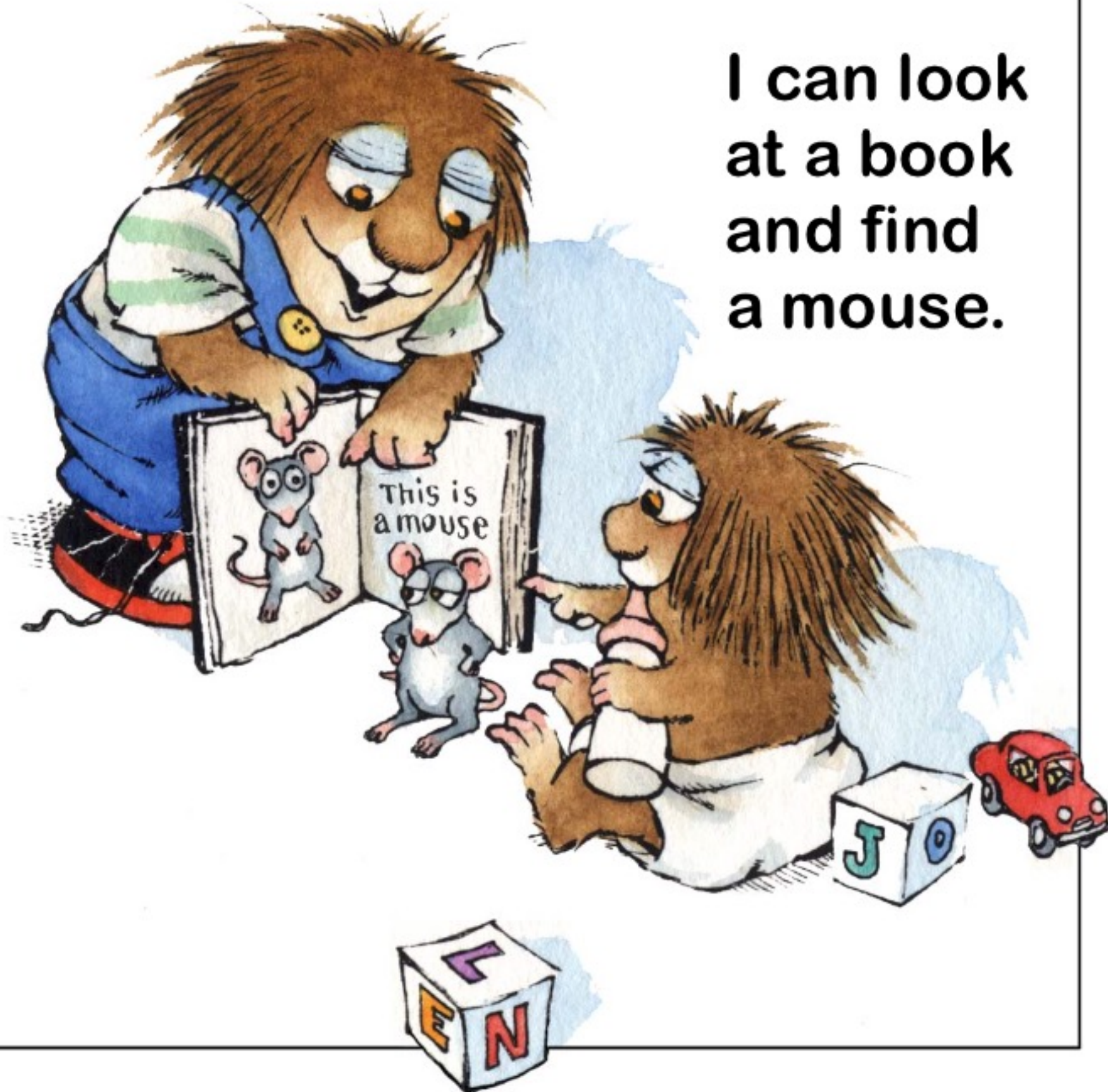

trim a bush...



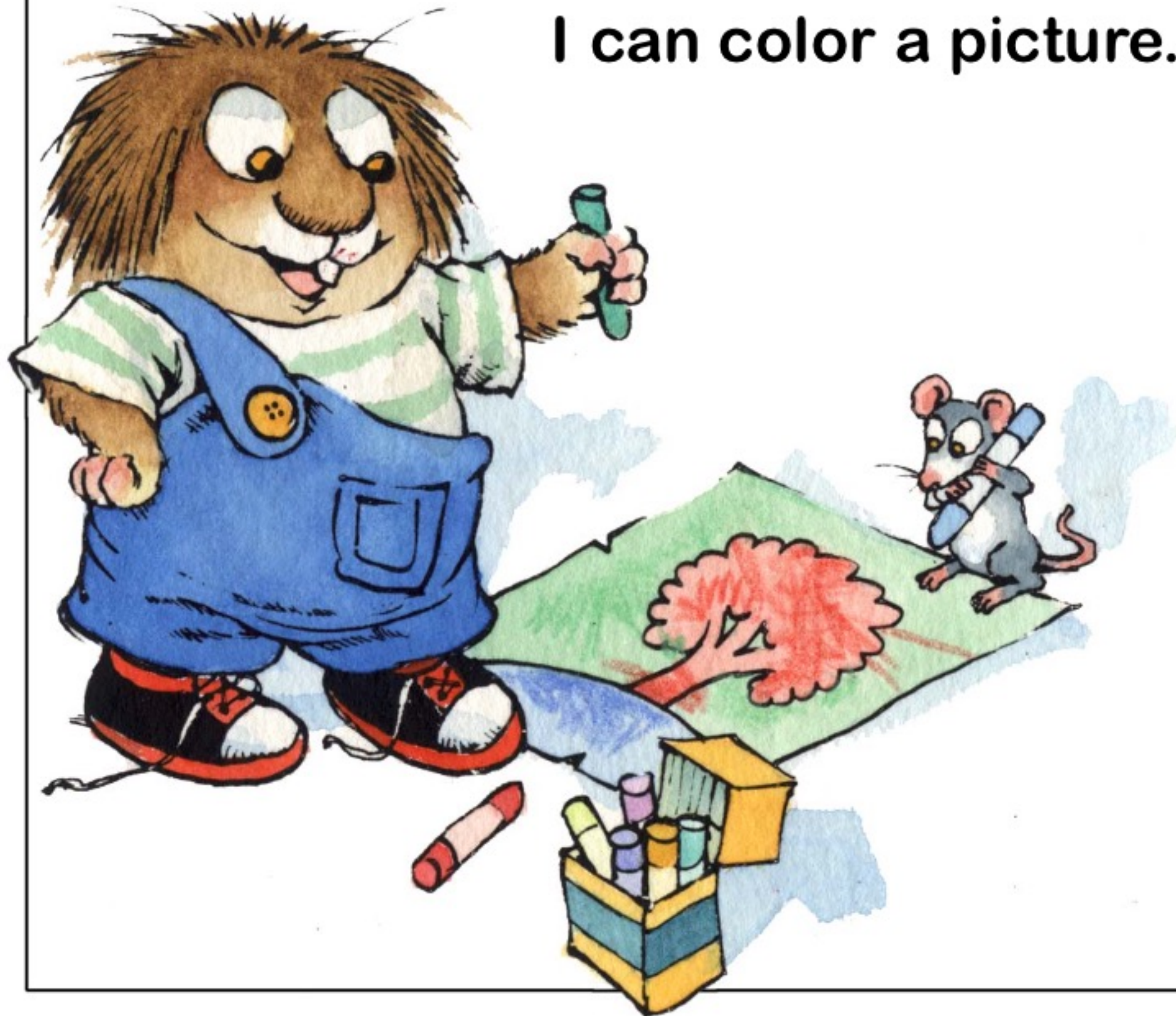

I can color a picture.



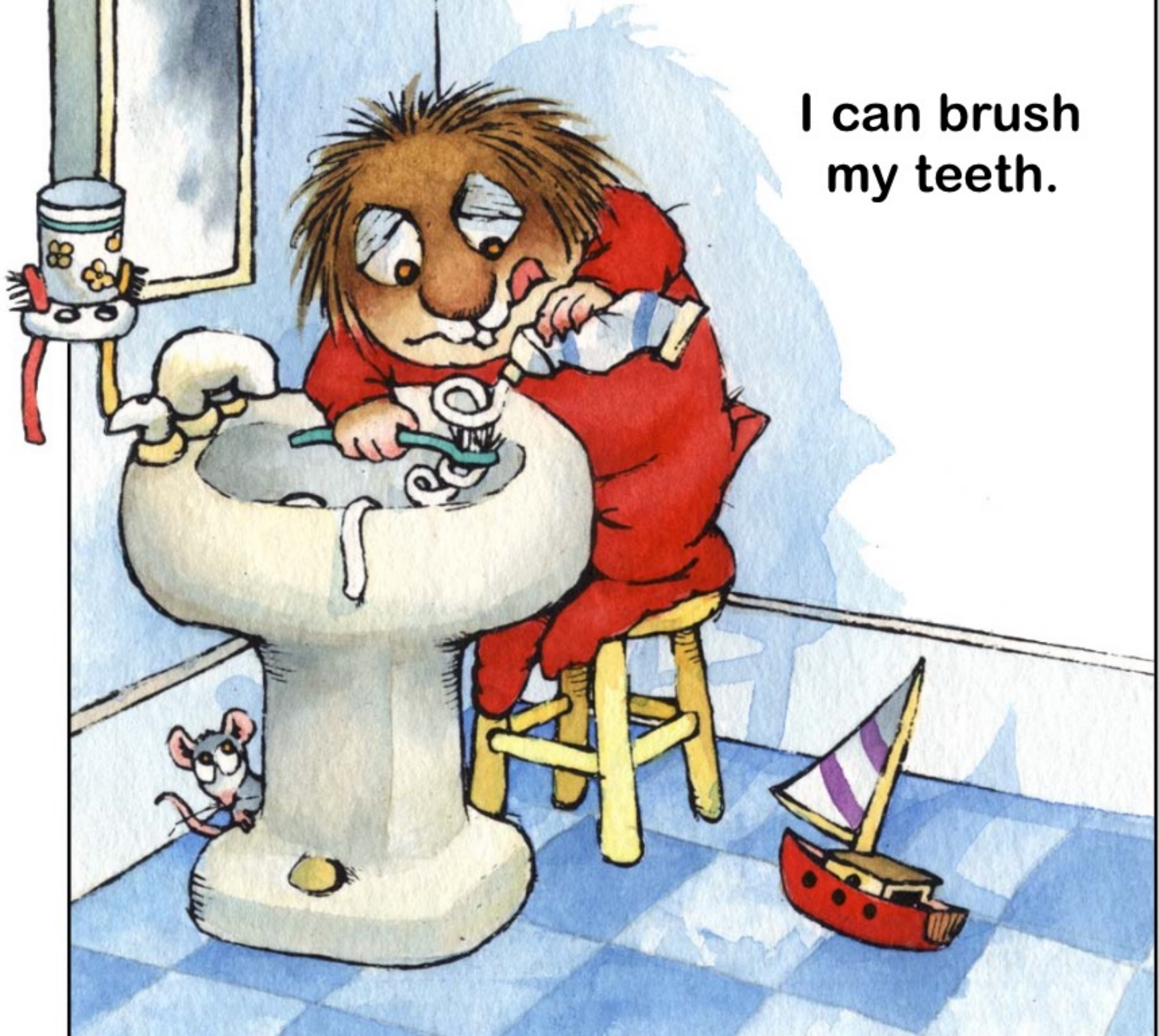
