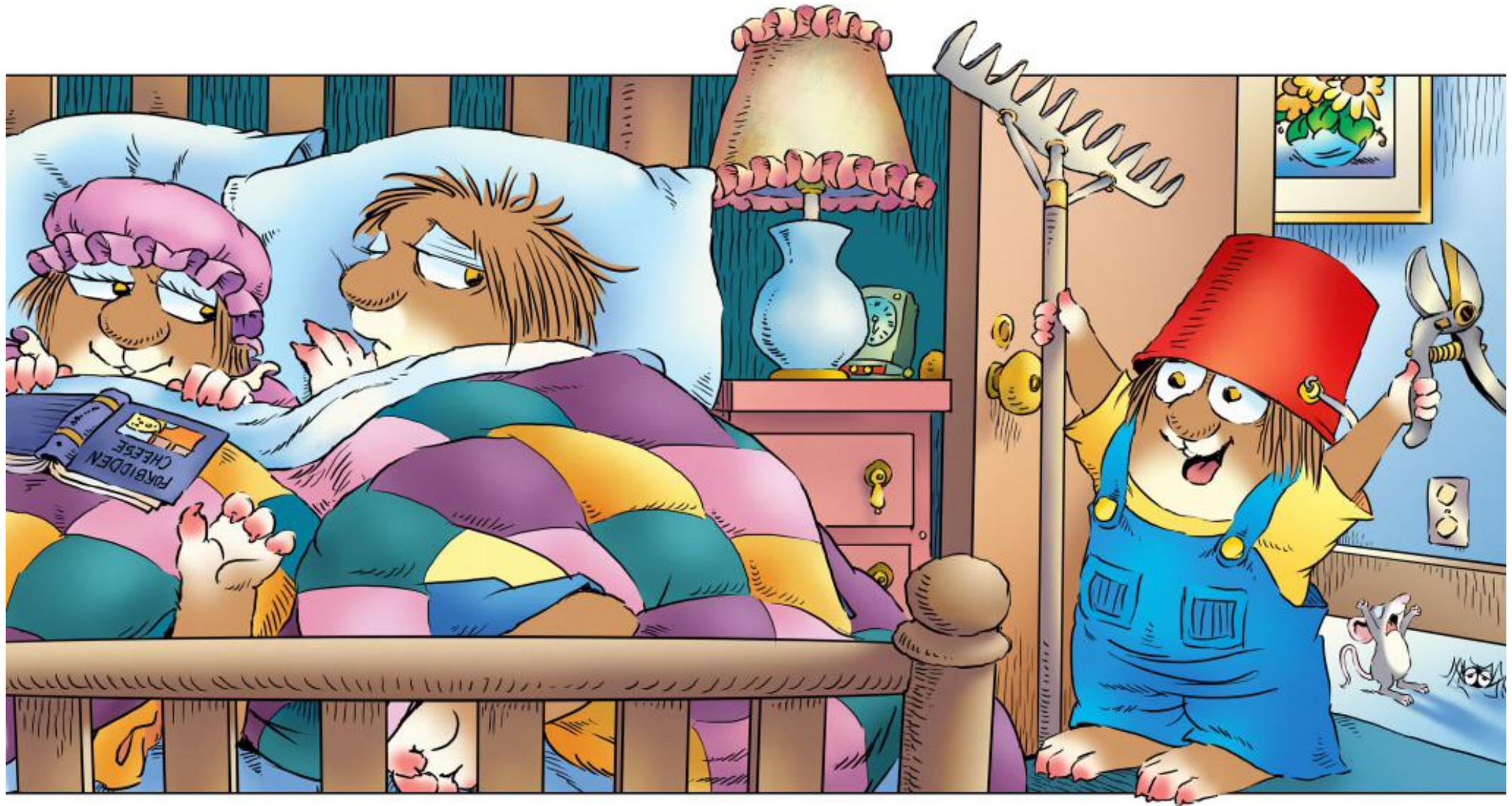
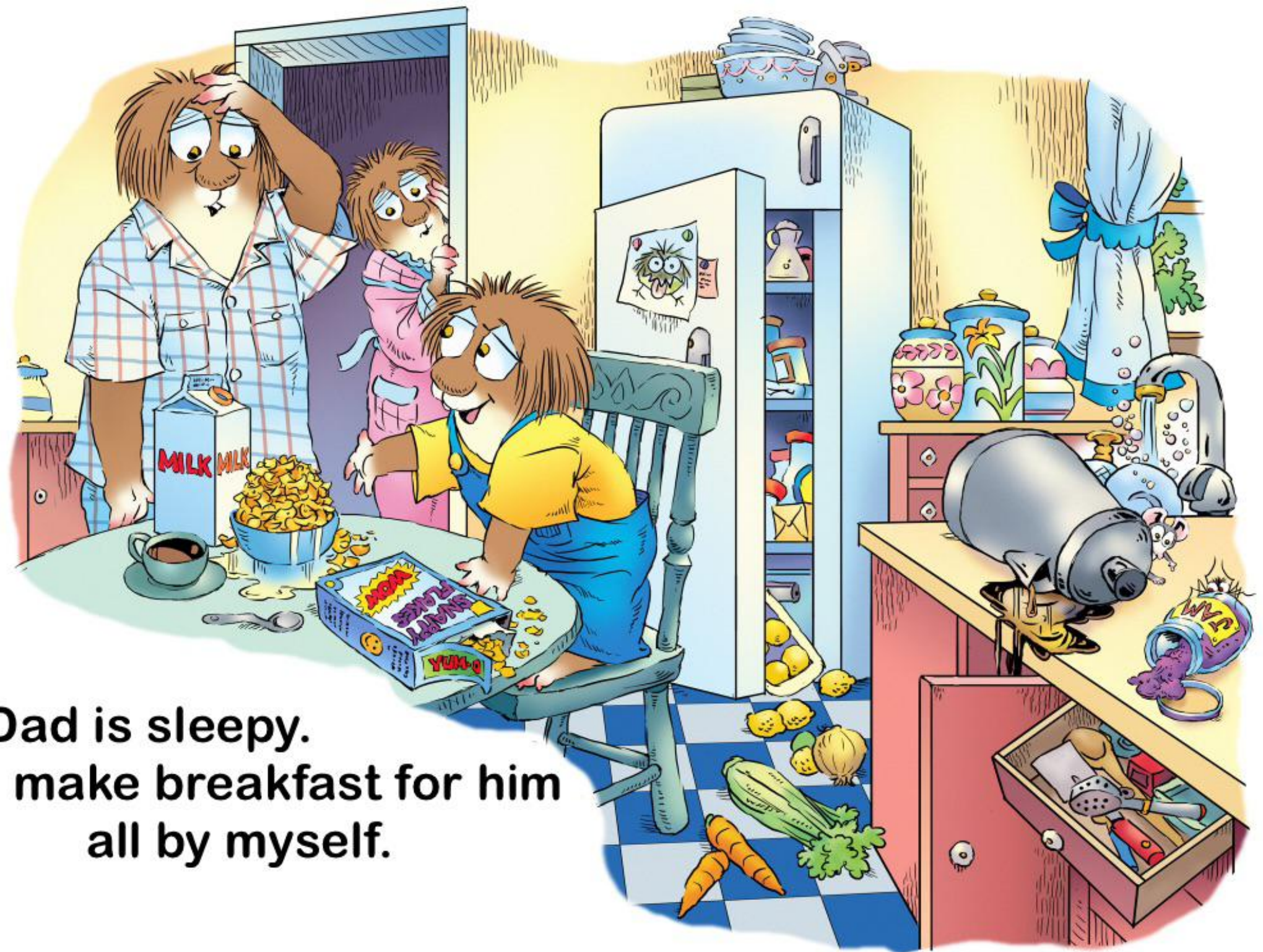




**Dad is home today.

I cut the grass.

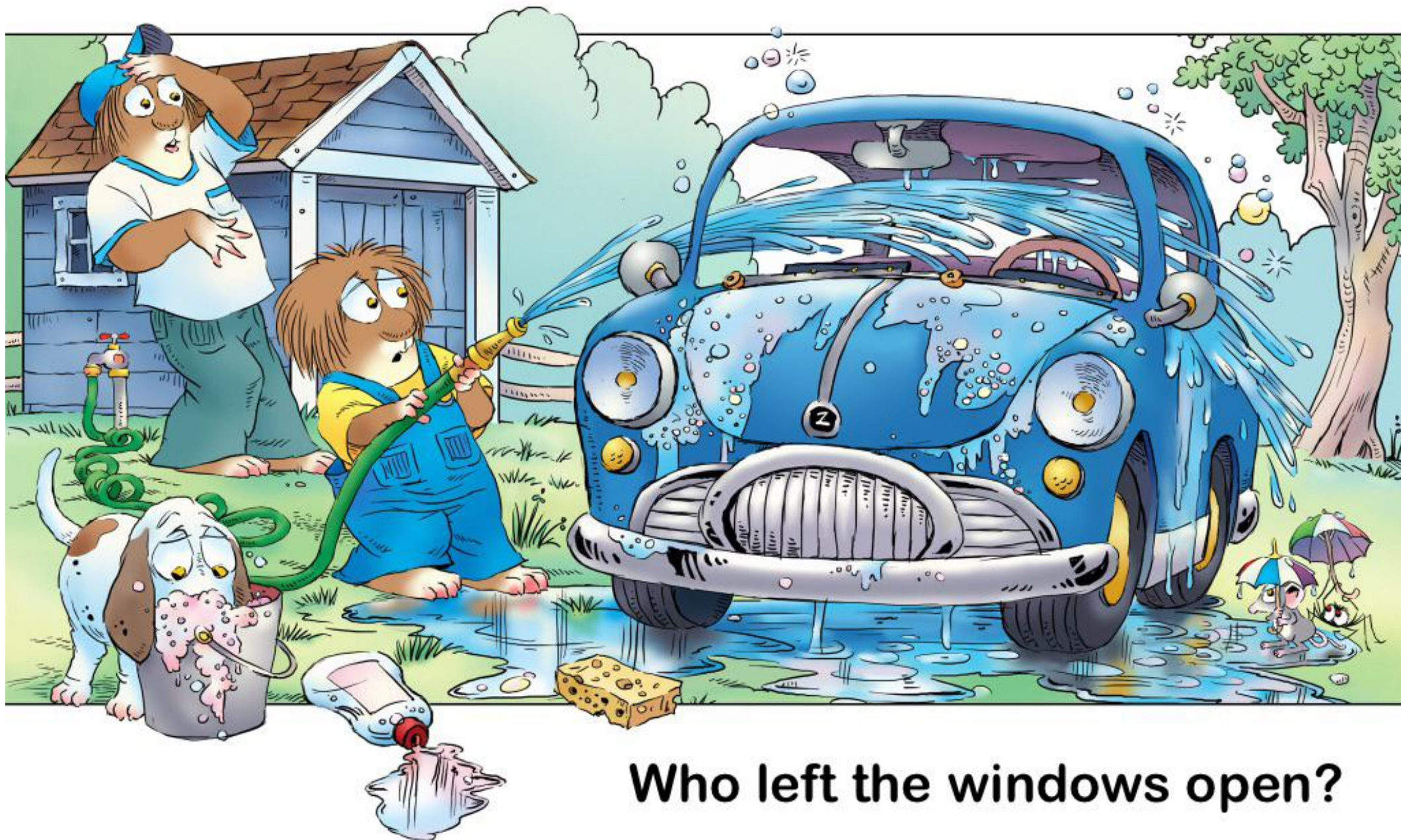




**Oops! The mower got away!

I wash the car, just for Dad.



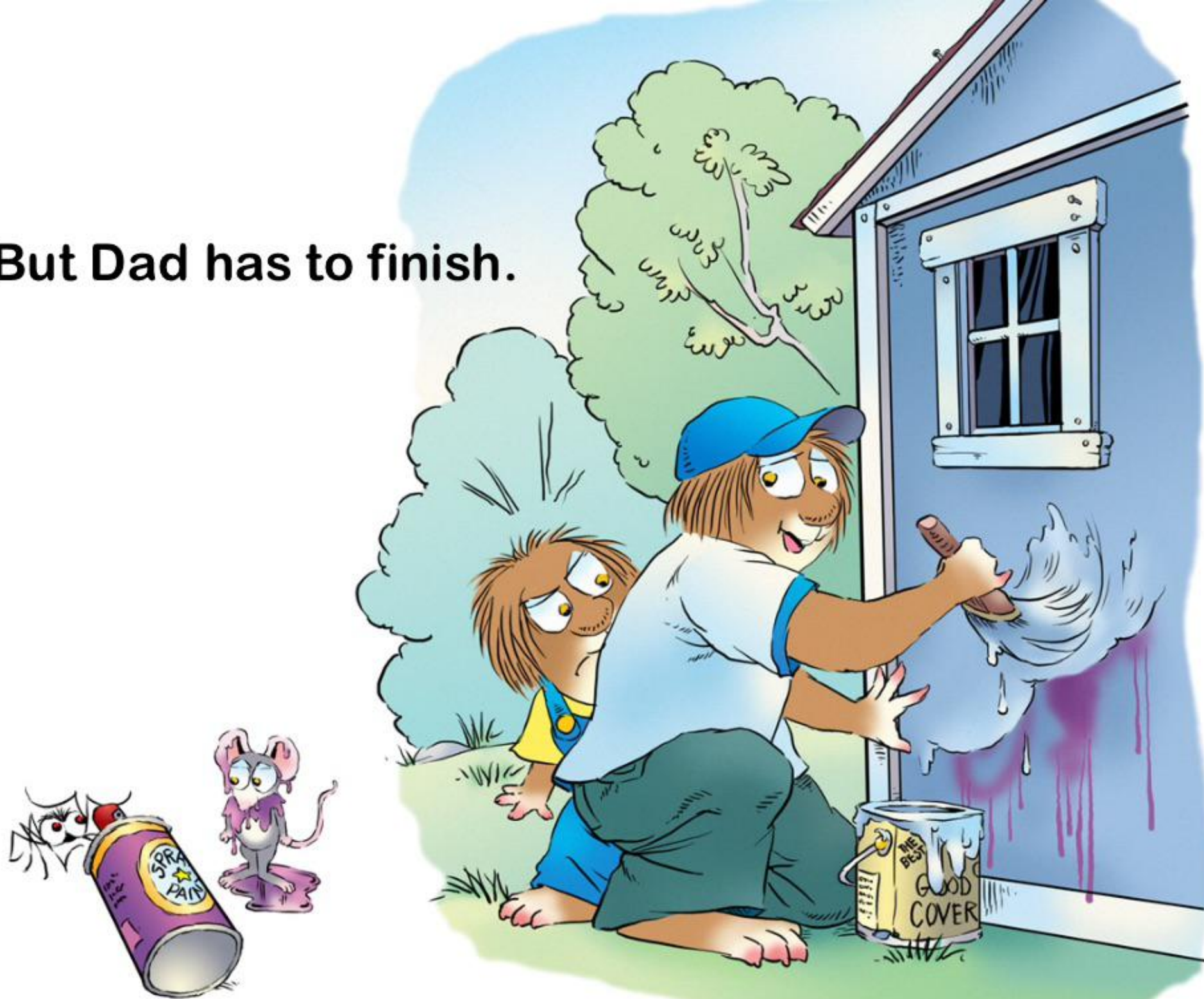


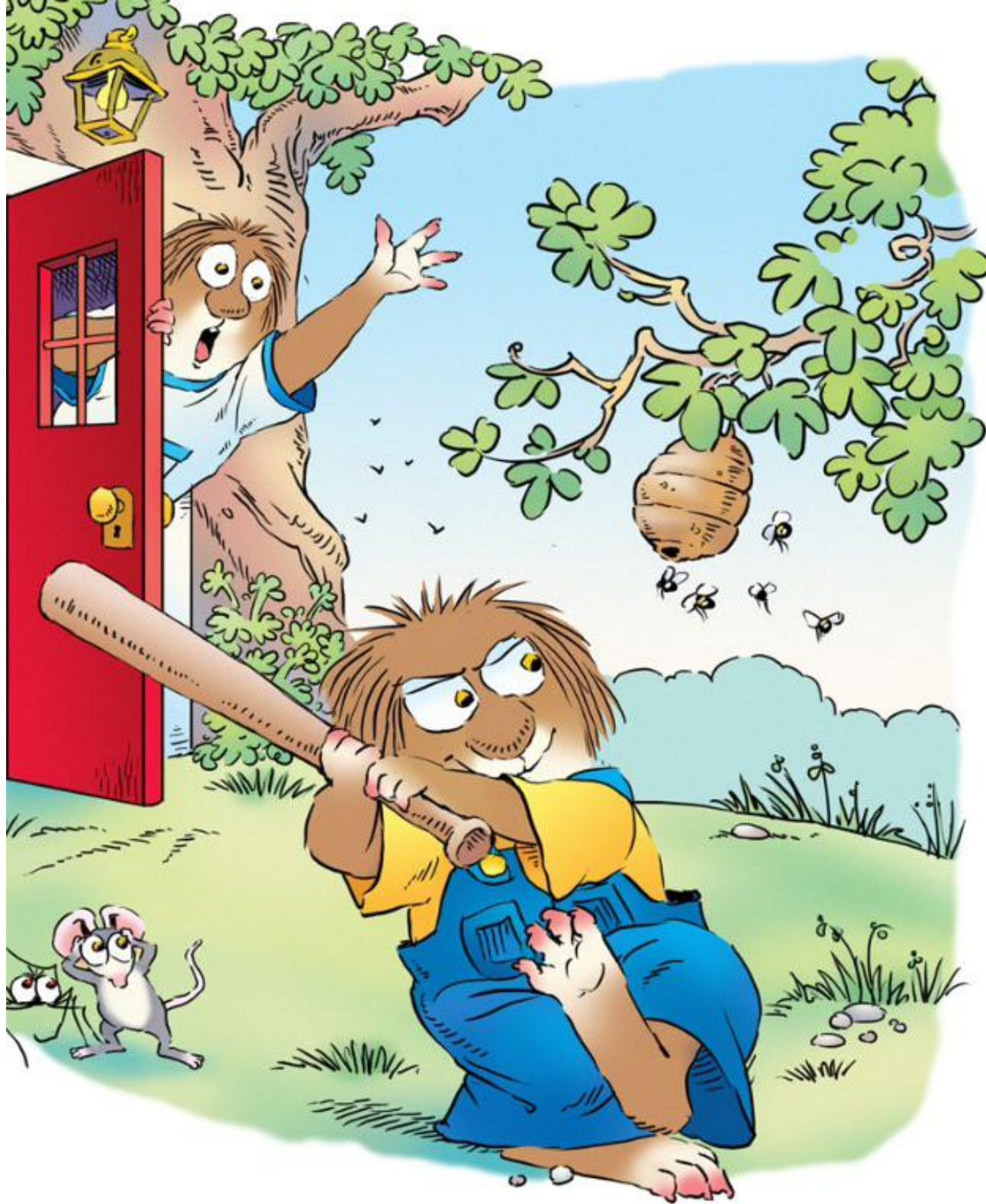
Who left the windows open?

But Dad has to finish.





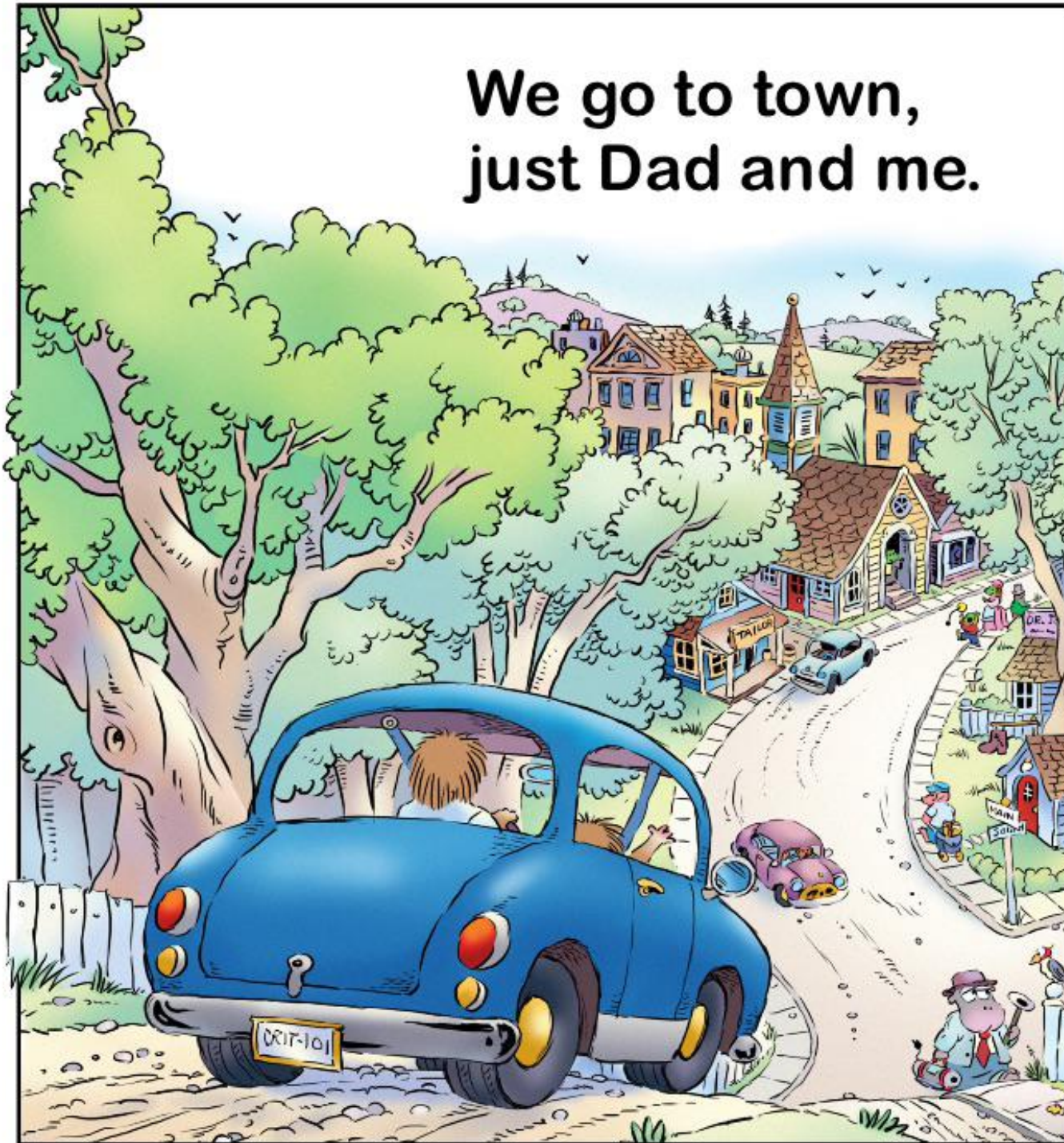
**I see a bees' nest.

just Dad and me.**

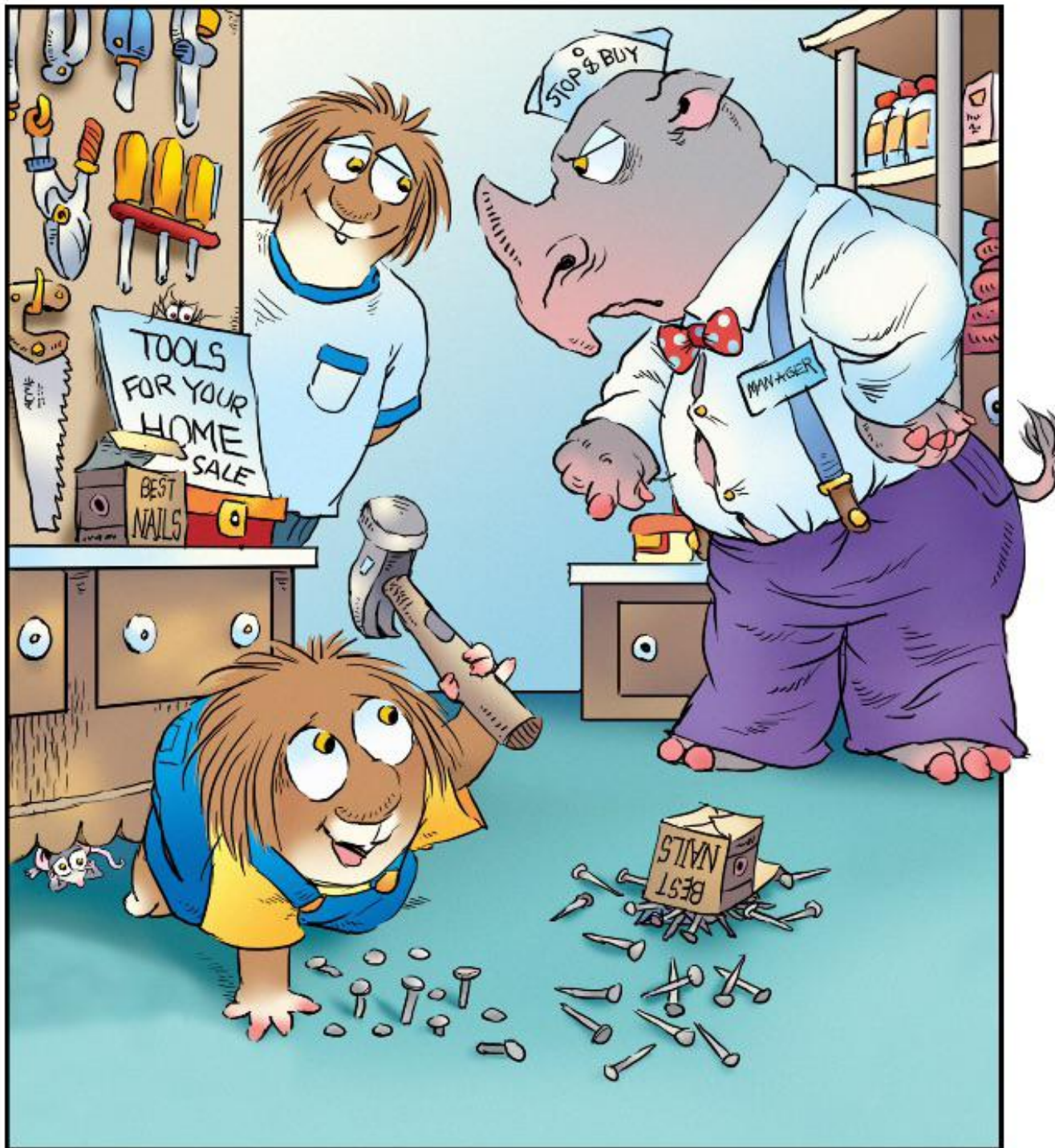


**We buy gas.

I call Dad.

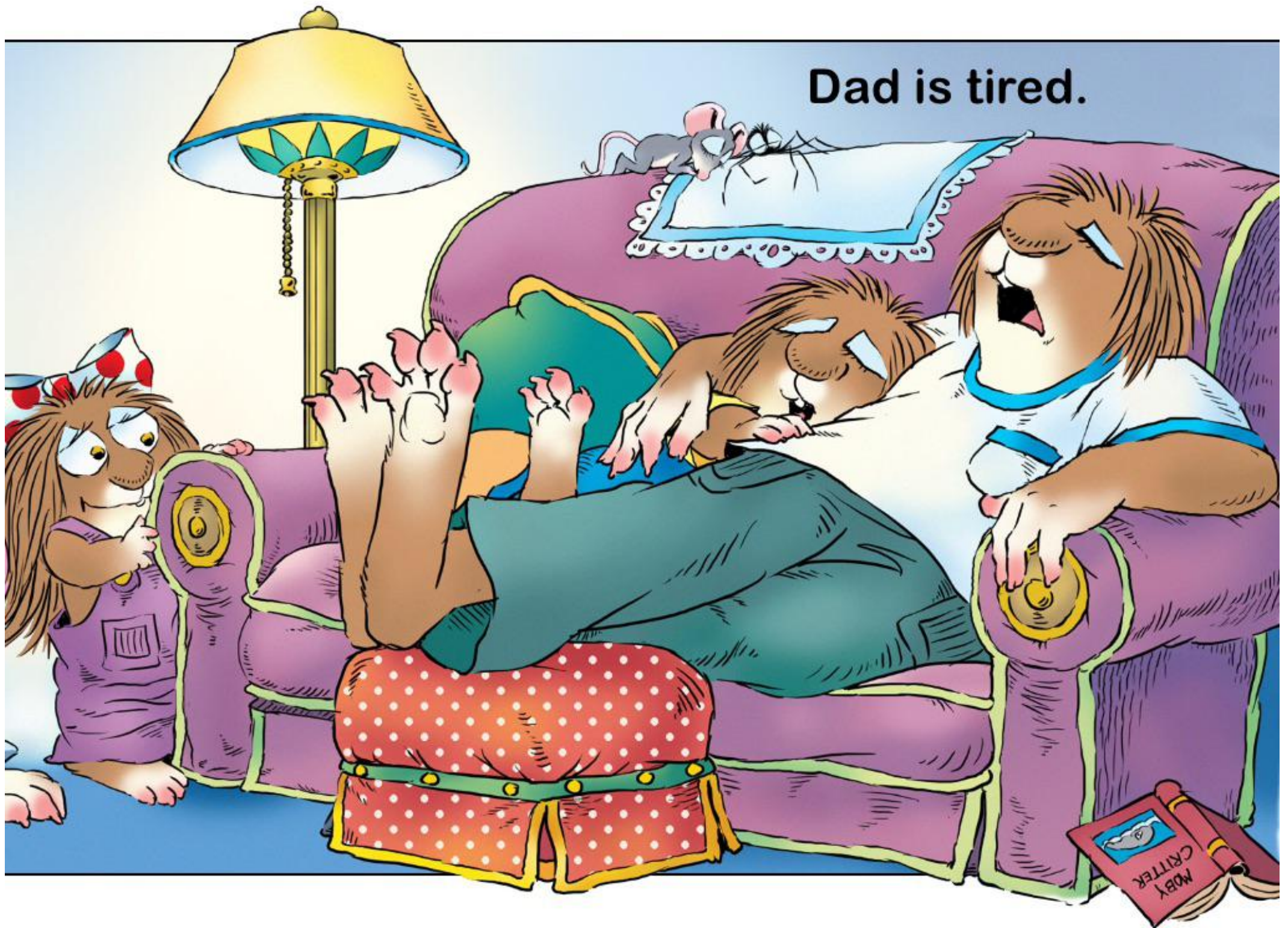
**I forgot to turn off the hose.

Grass loves water!"**



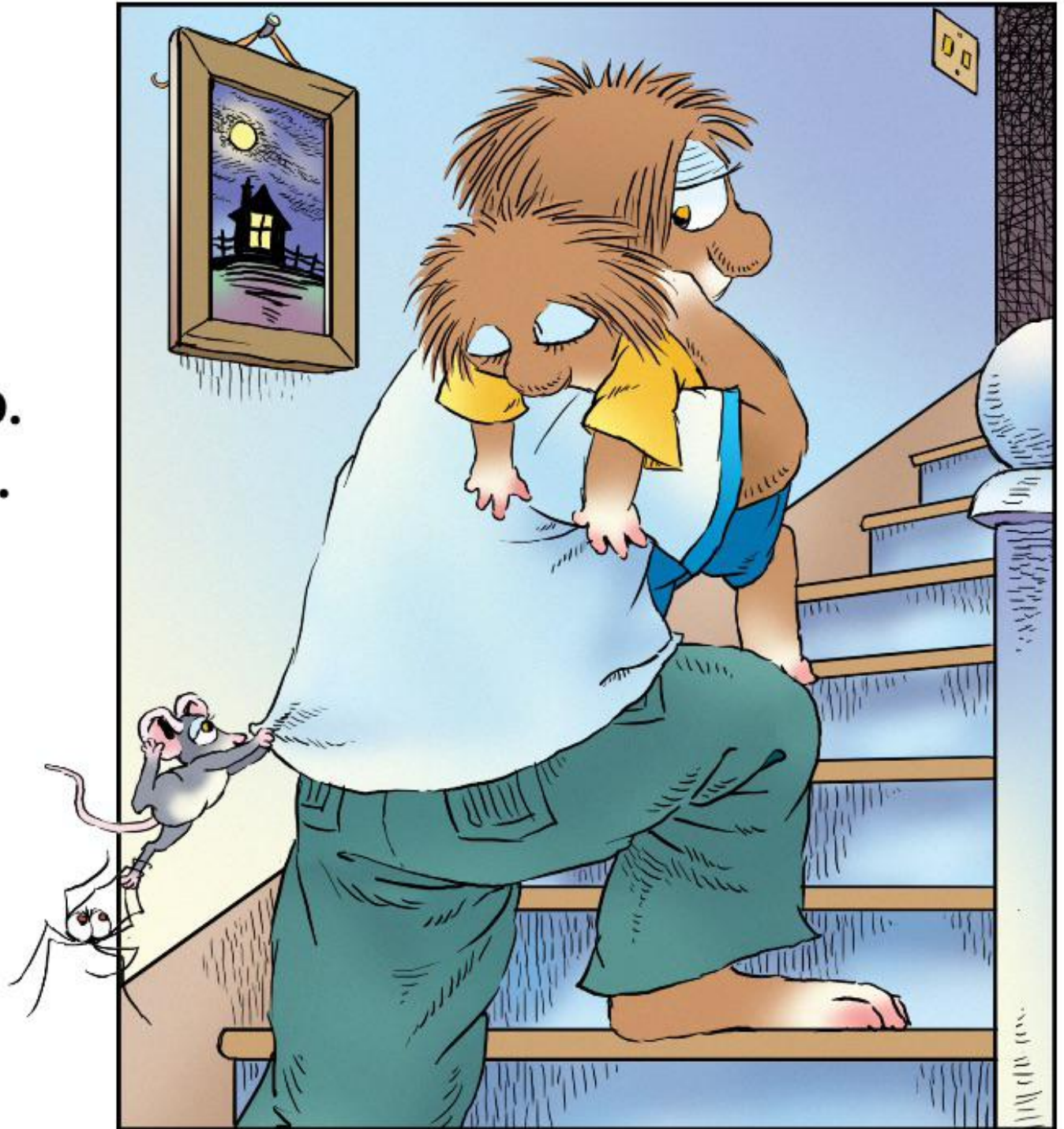
We have dinner.
Then Dad and I watch a movie.



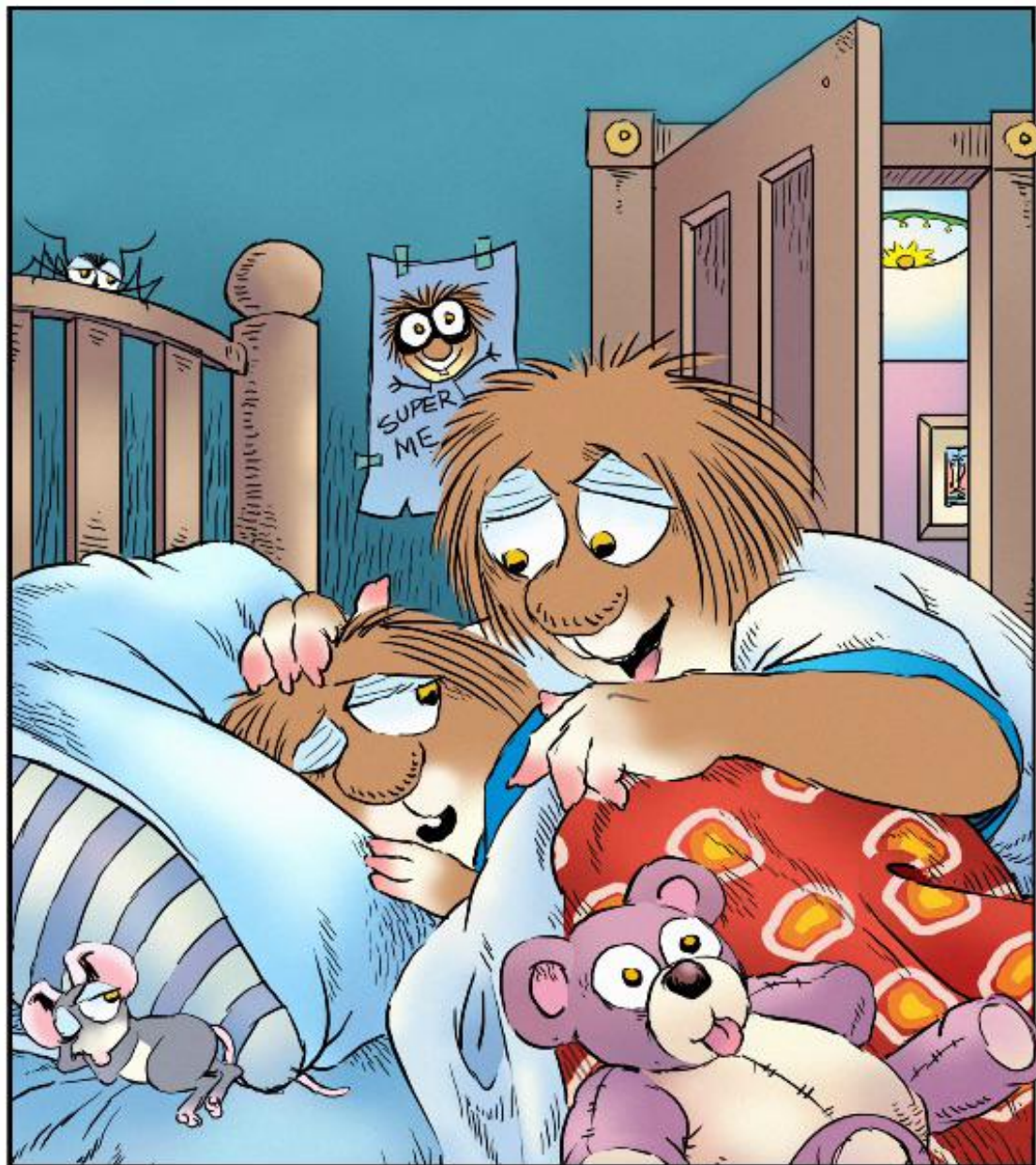
Dad is tired.

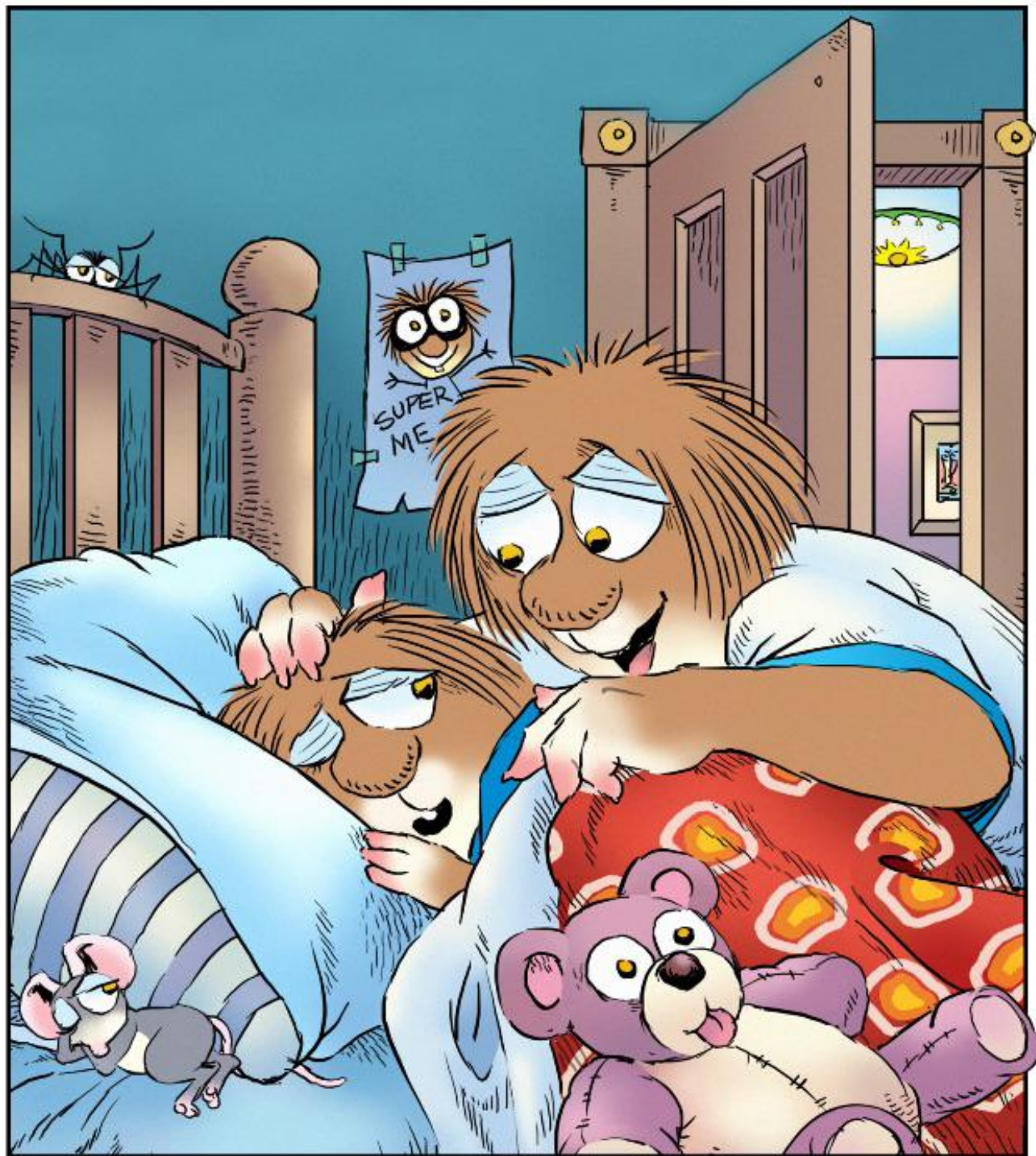


**It's time to sleep.
