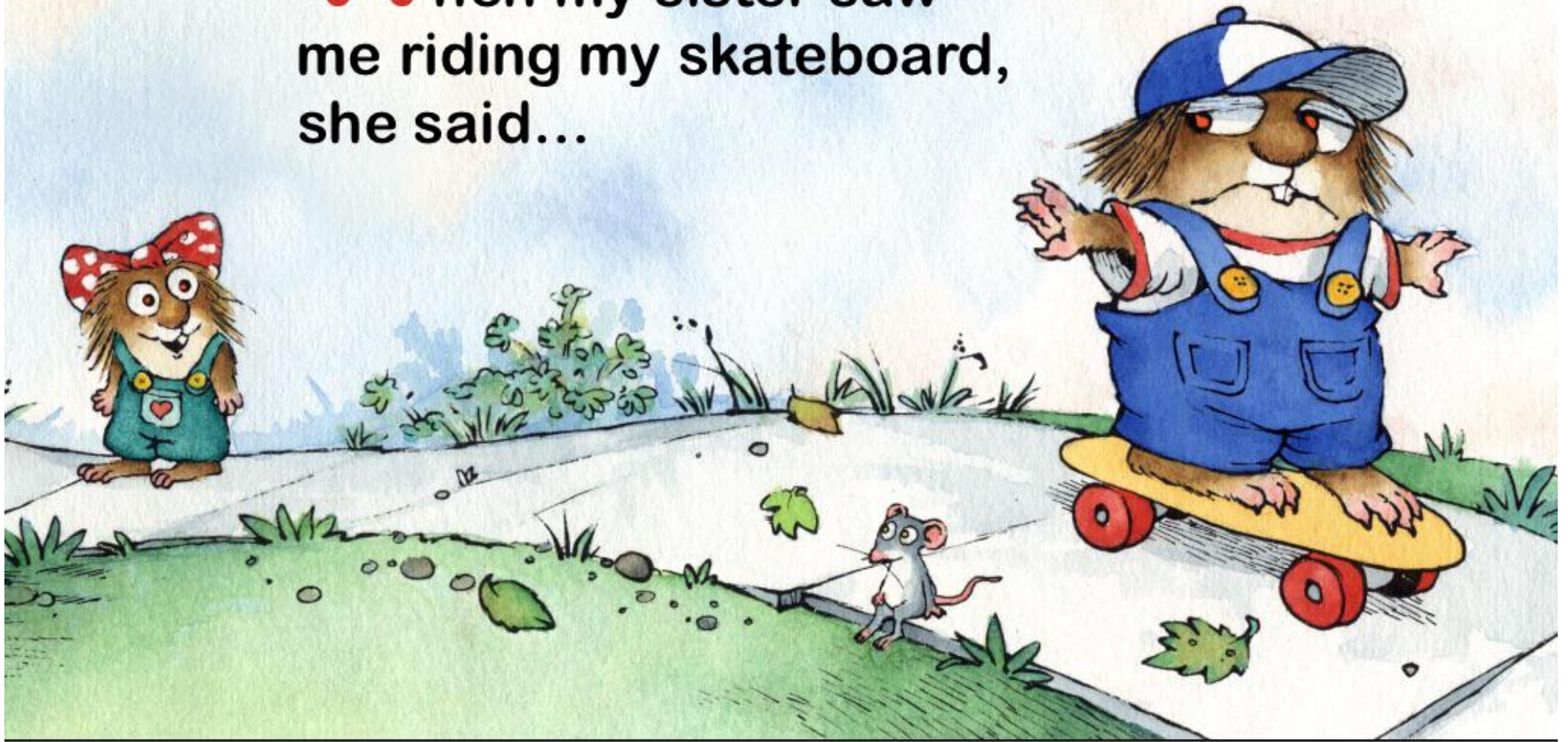


**W**hen my sister saw

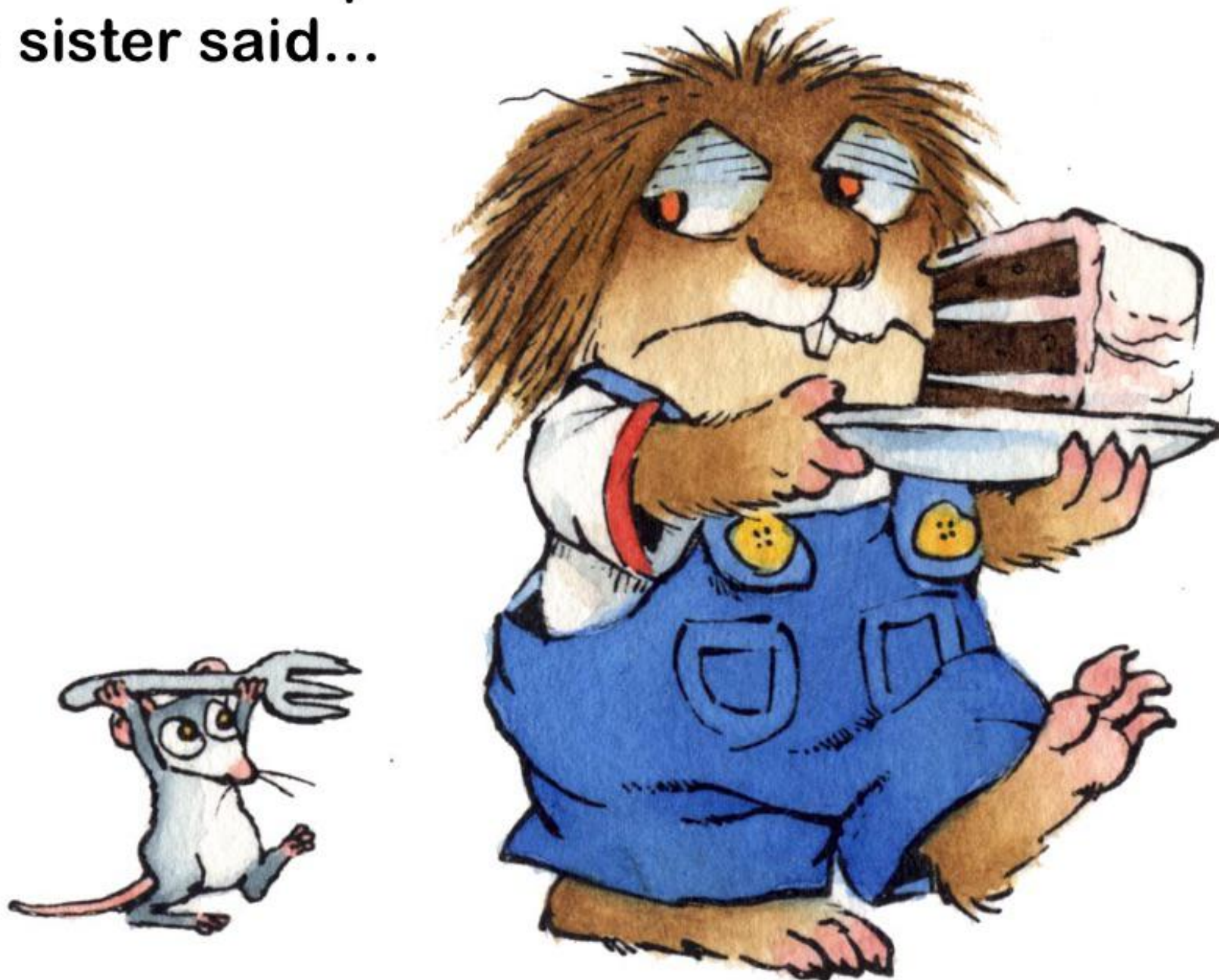


She doesn't

My little sister said...



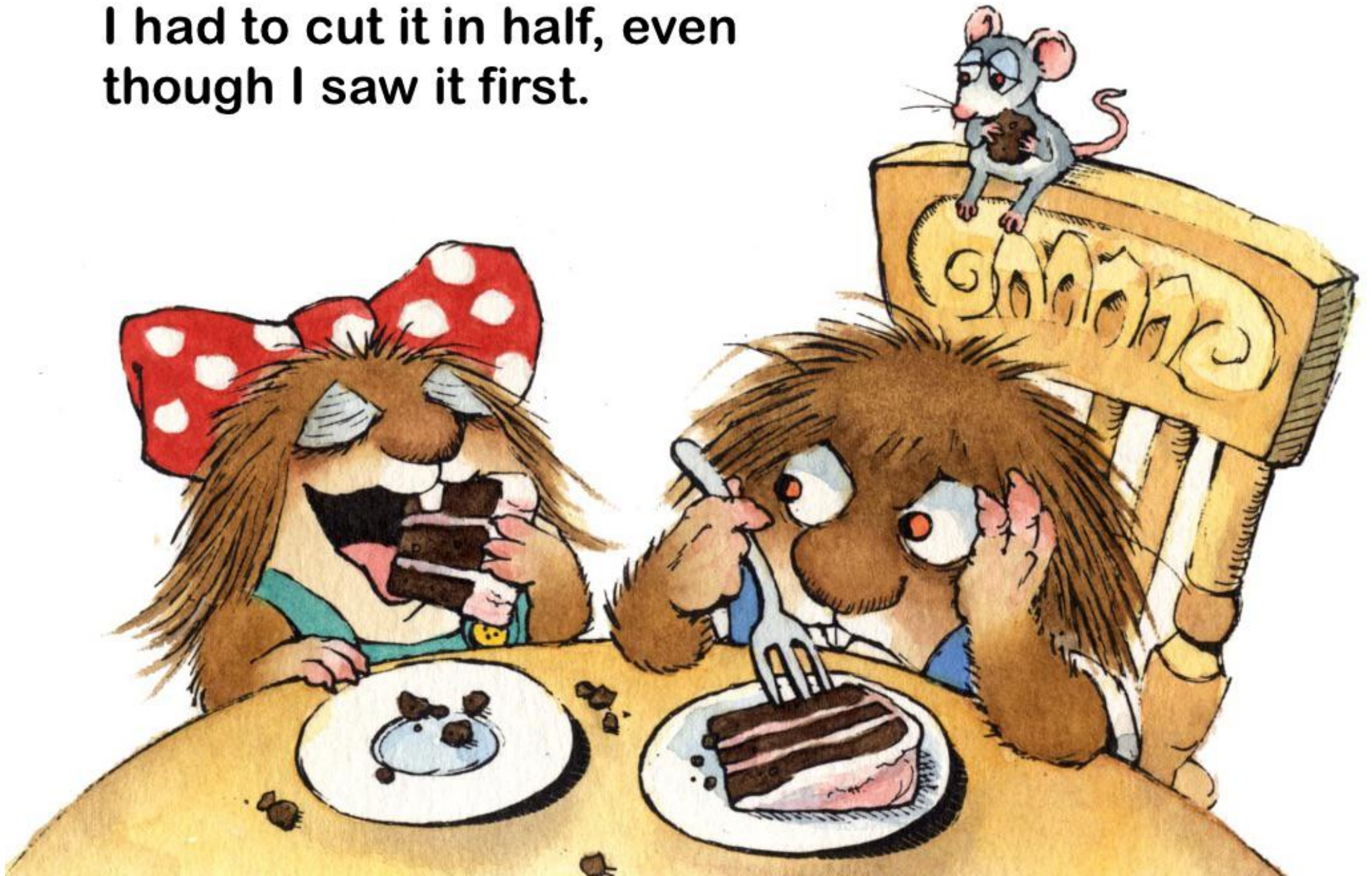


Me too!





I had to cut it in half, even though I saw it first.

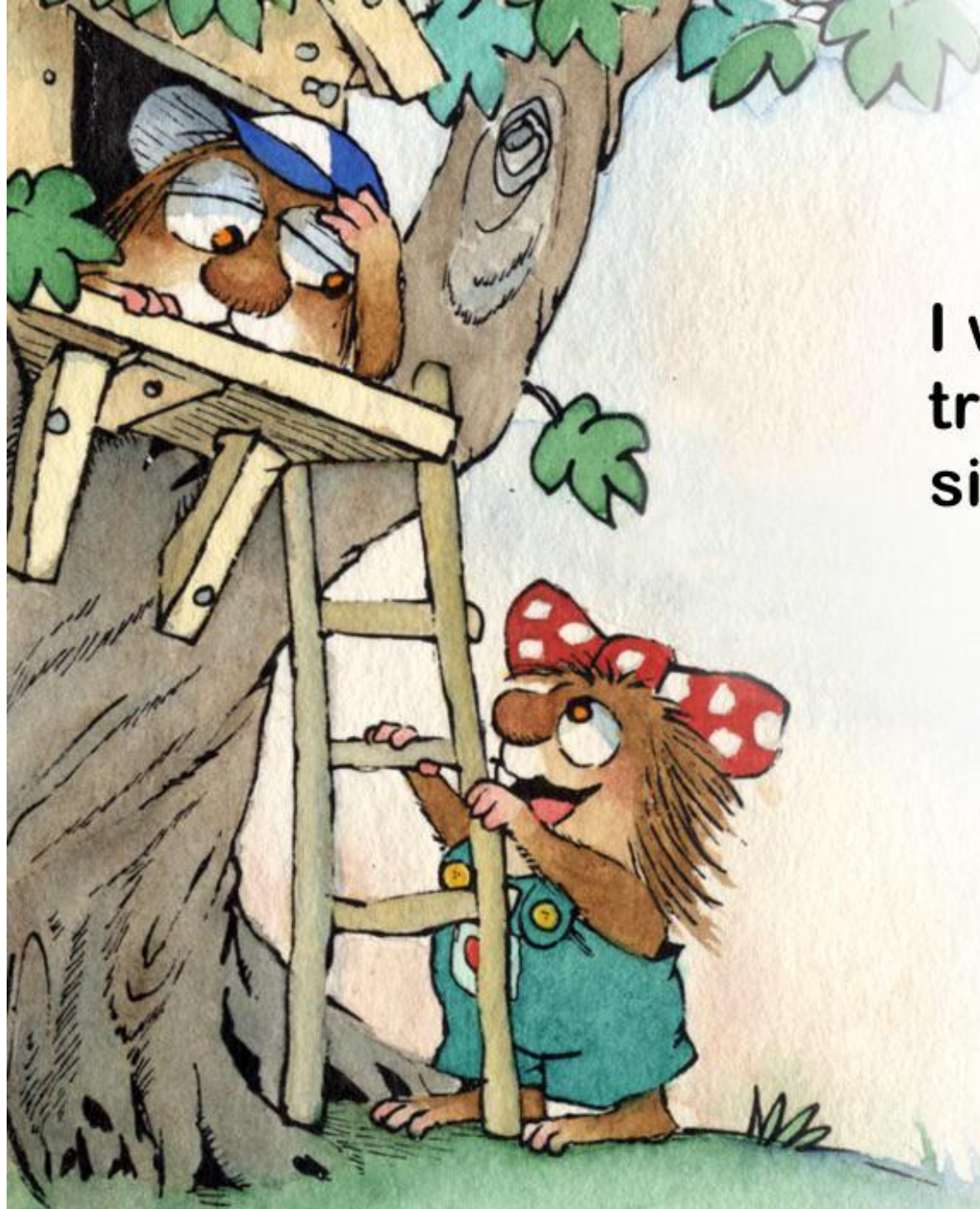




**When I went fishing she said, "Me too!"

sister said...



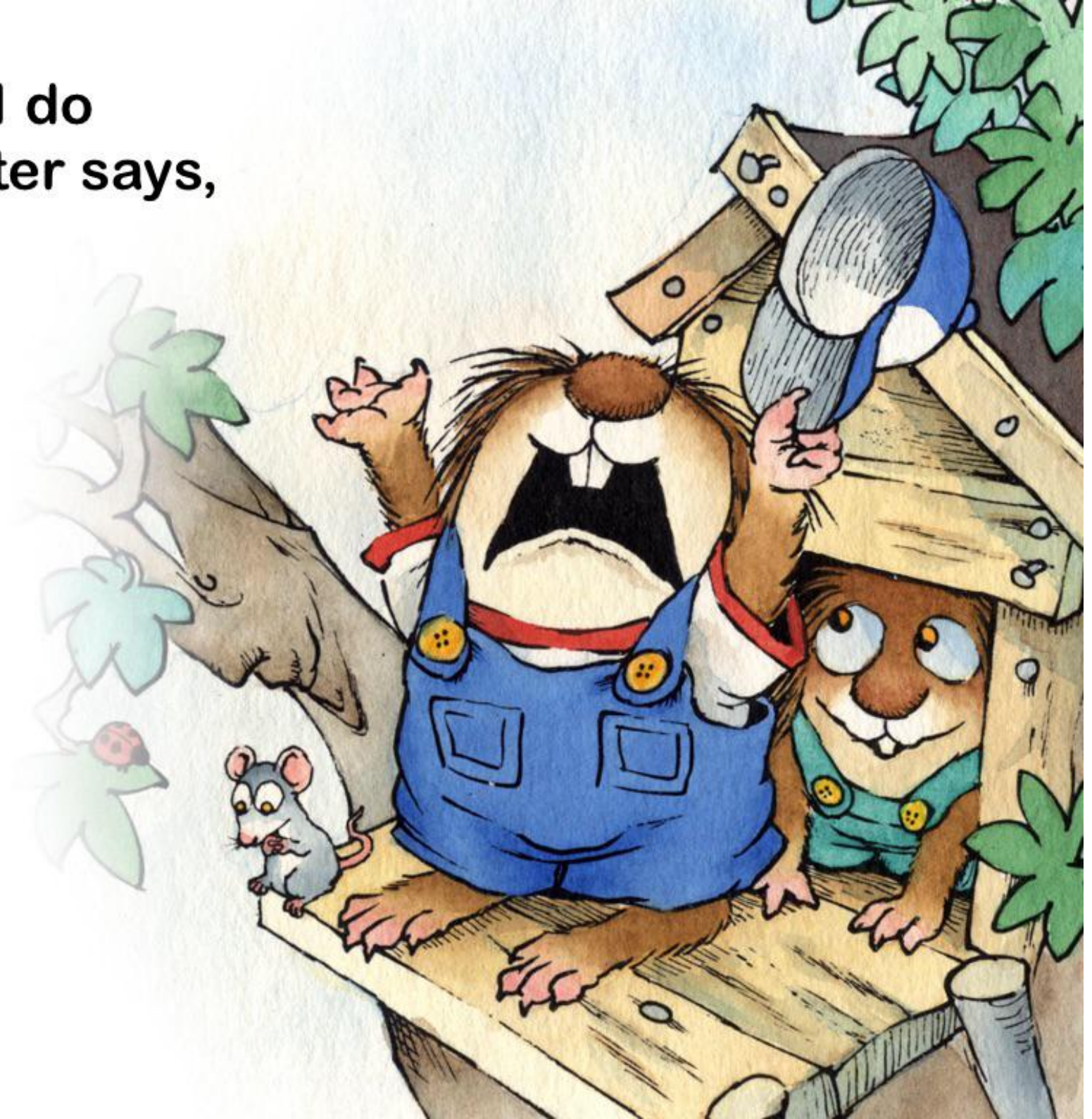


Me too!

to help her up.

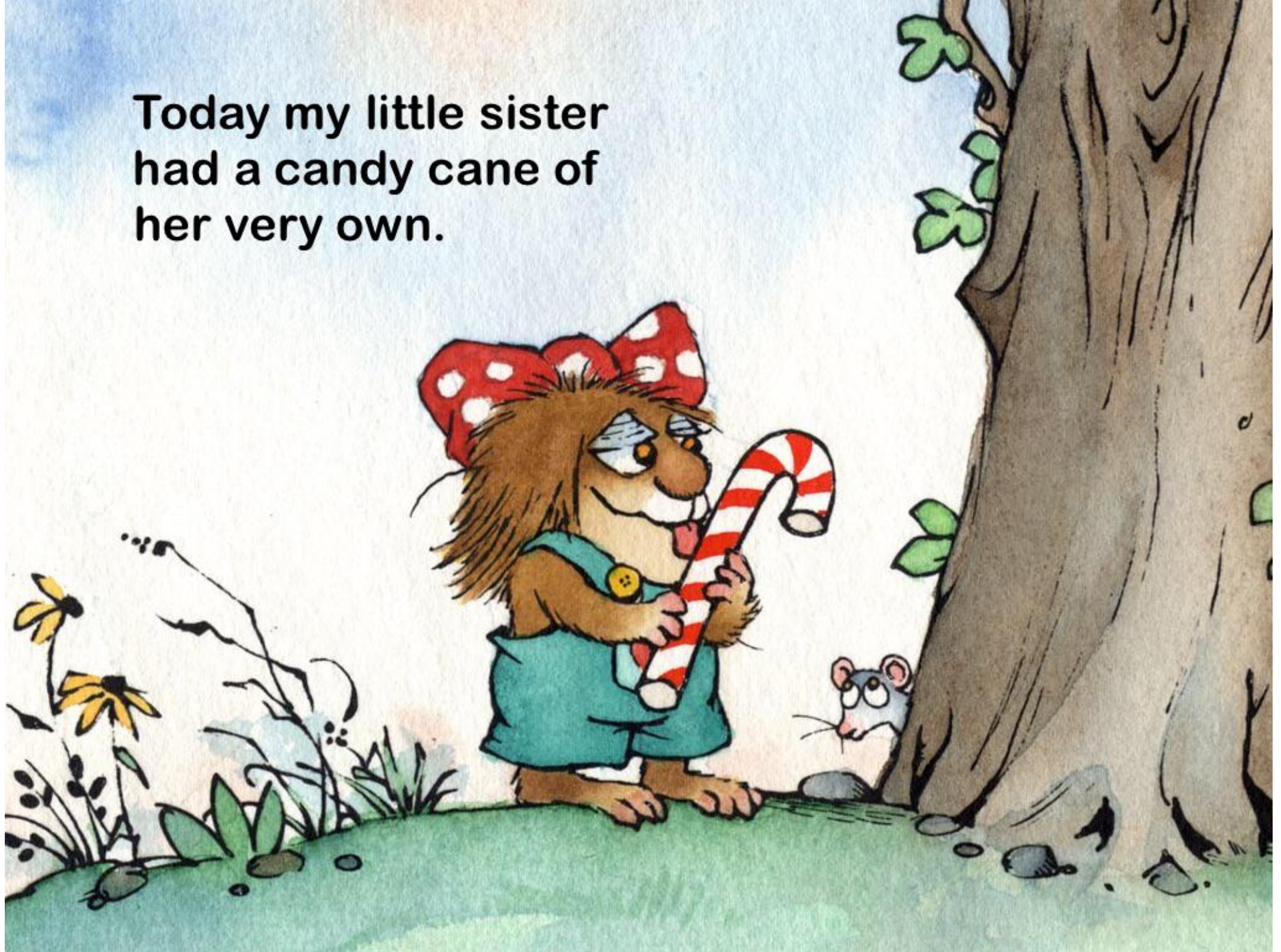


Everything I do

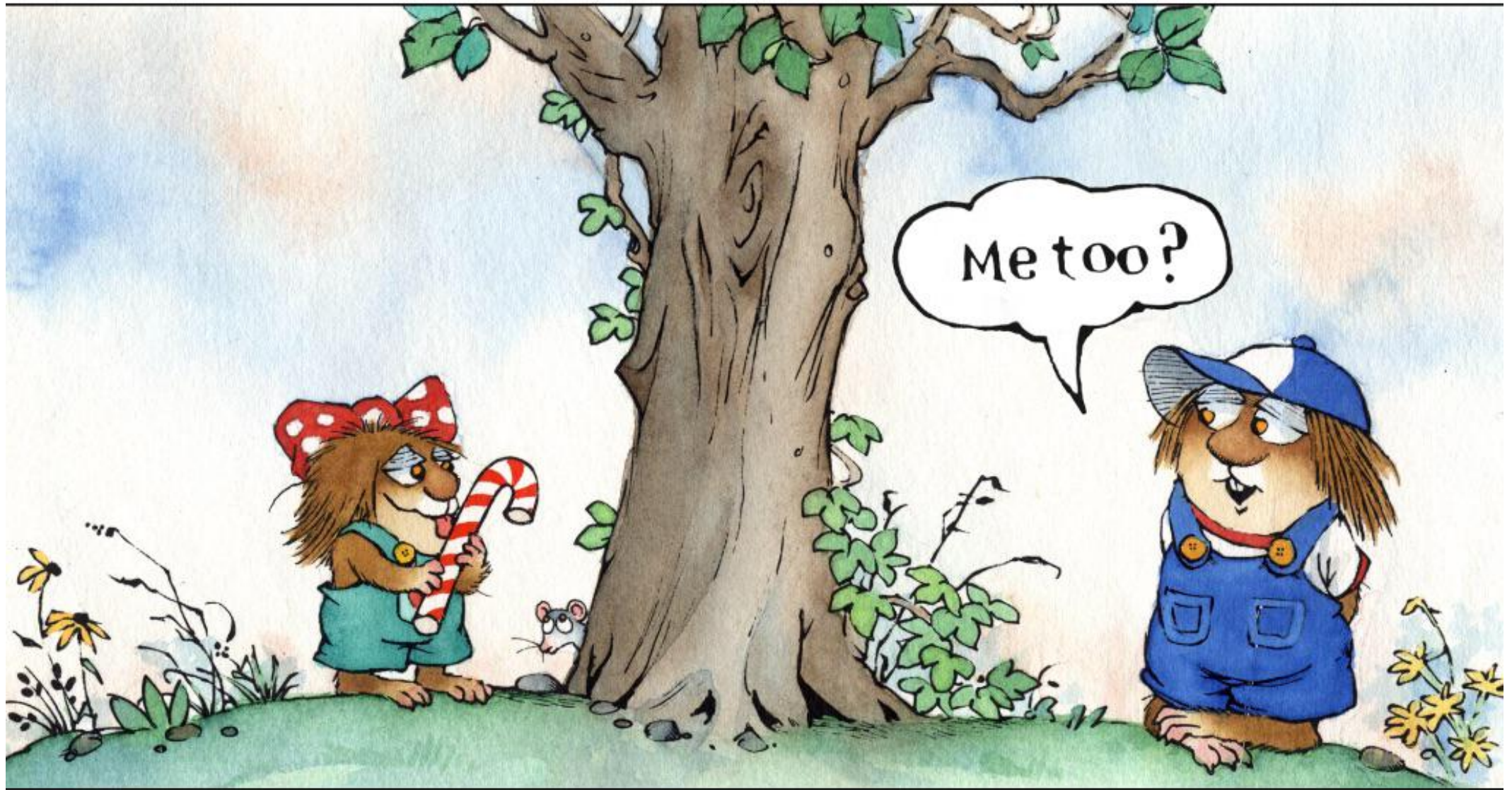


Today my little sister
