

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


"Hello there," said the fire chief.

He started to chew on his leash.




The chief showed the family all over the firehouse.

Marley saw what was cooking in the kitchen.


He tried out the chairs in the day room.





Marley rested in the sleeping room.


Marley took a look at the classroom lessons.


