Caillou copied whatever Sarah did. This time, he managed to make a perfect, round snowball.







Caillou looked down at his snowball and then over at Sarah. He had a mischievous idea. He threw the snowball at his friend.

"Stop it," Sarah warned. But Caillou's snowball was already flying through the air and hit Sarah on the head.






Caillou and Sarah each made another snowball and rolled them through the snow. This time, they both ended up in the middle of the yard.

"We have to put our snowman together. First, let's put this ball on top of the biggest one," said Sarah.




Caillou reached into the bag and pulled out a carrot. He wondered what it was for.
"A perfect nose for our snowman!" said Sarah.





"Look really carefully in the bag," Mommy said. This time, Caillou found two buttons, which he used for the snowman's eyes.
