





It was a beautiful day and George was curious.
He was curious about all the boats on the river.




George liked one boat best of all. It was carrying cars!

Bill showed George his model sailboat.


George thought it was wonderful.

"I saved a lot of money to build this boat," Bill said. "Will you keep it safe until the contest?"




George was happy to help. He held the boat very carefully.

George made Bill's boat look just like a ferryboat.


Oh, no! It sank. What would Bill enter into the contest now?




George looked at other boats on the river.

Now water cannot get inside and the boat will float.


Let's go enter our boats in the contest!"
