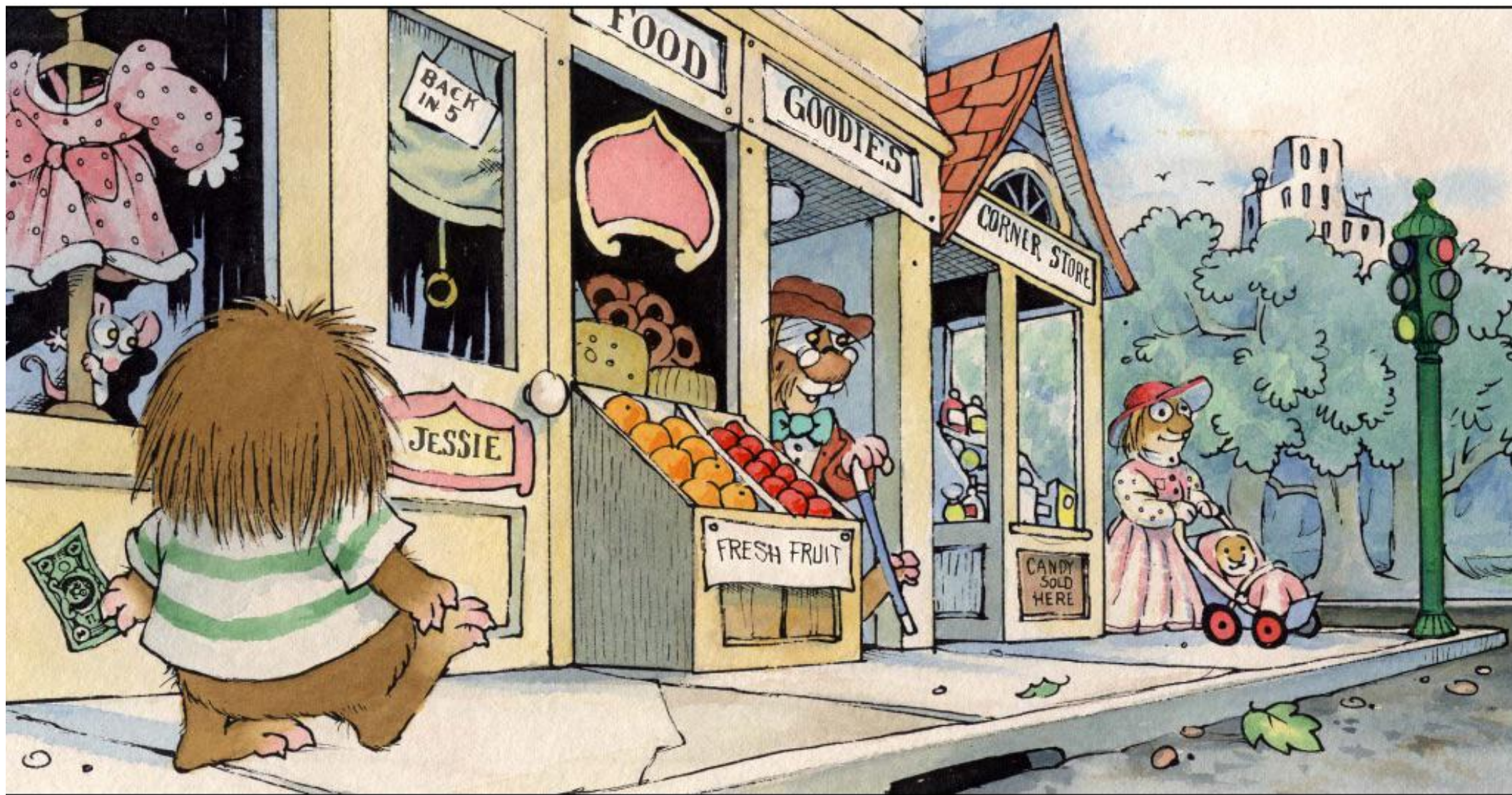


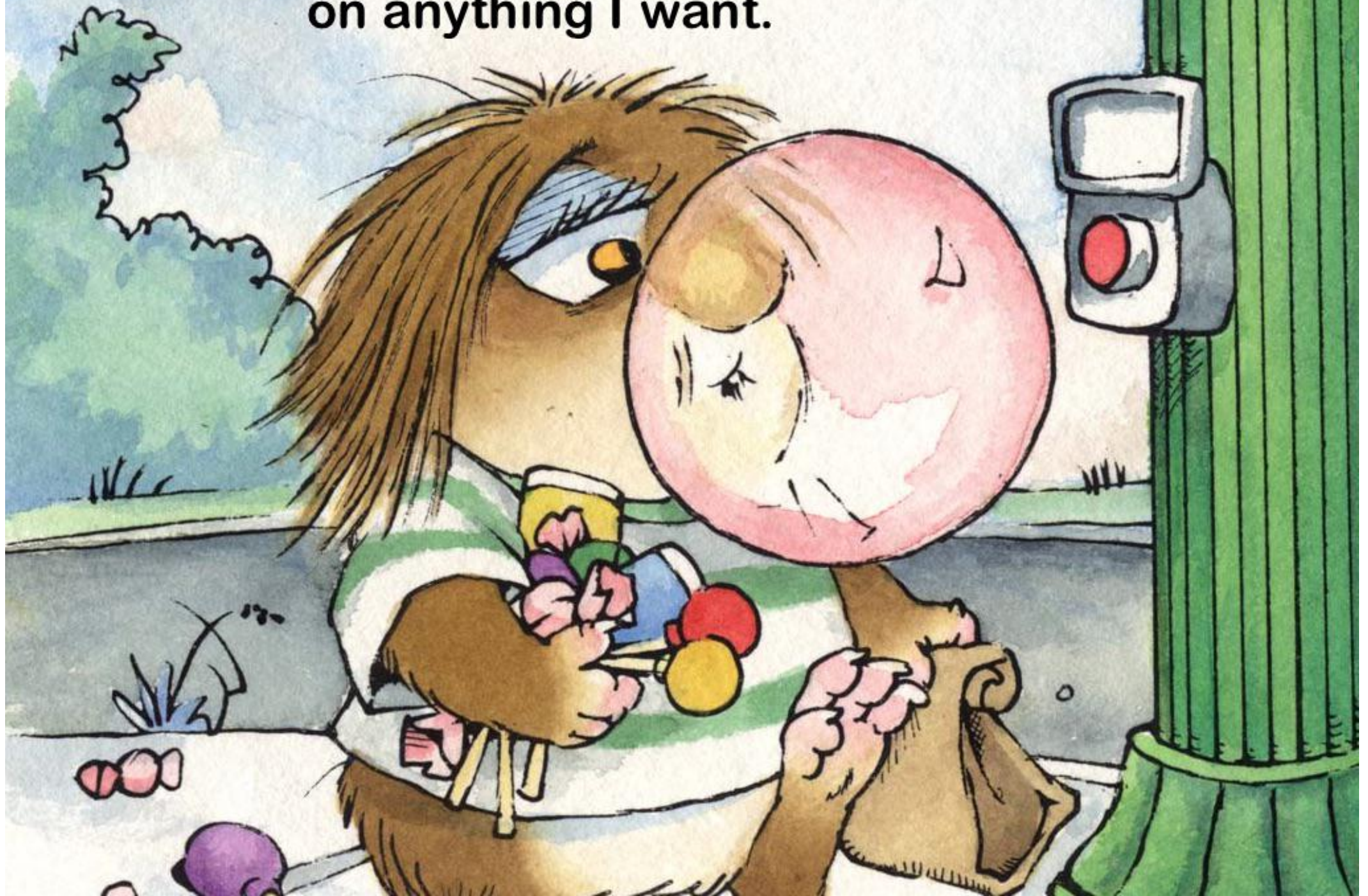
When I get bigger

lots of things.



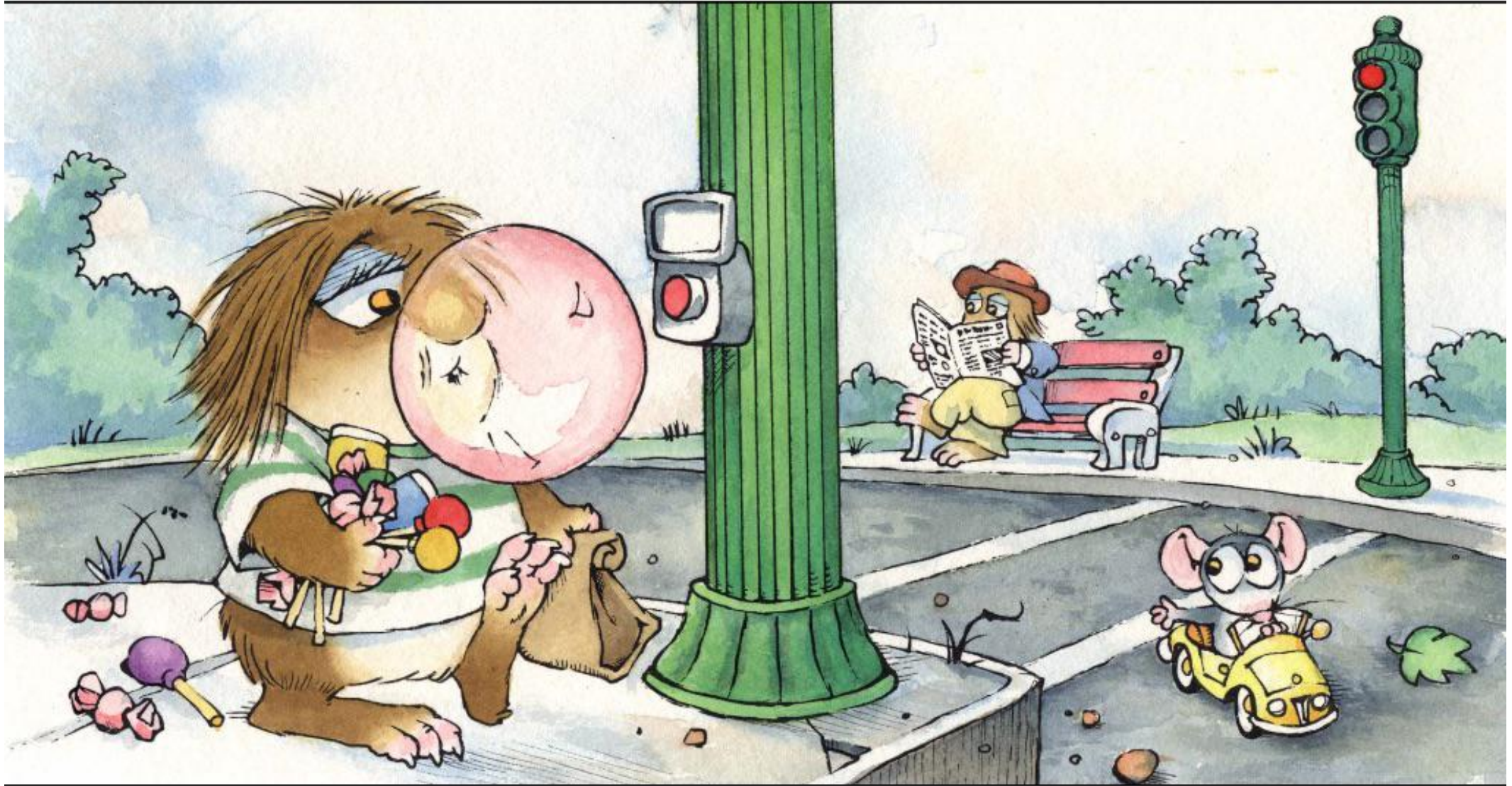
I'll go to the corner store by myself...

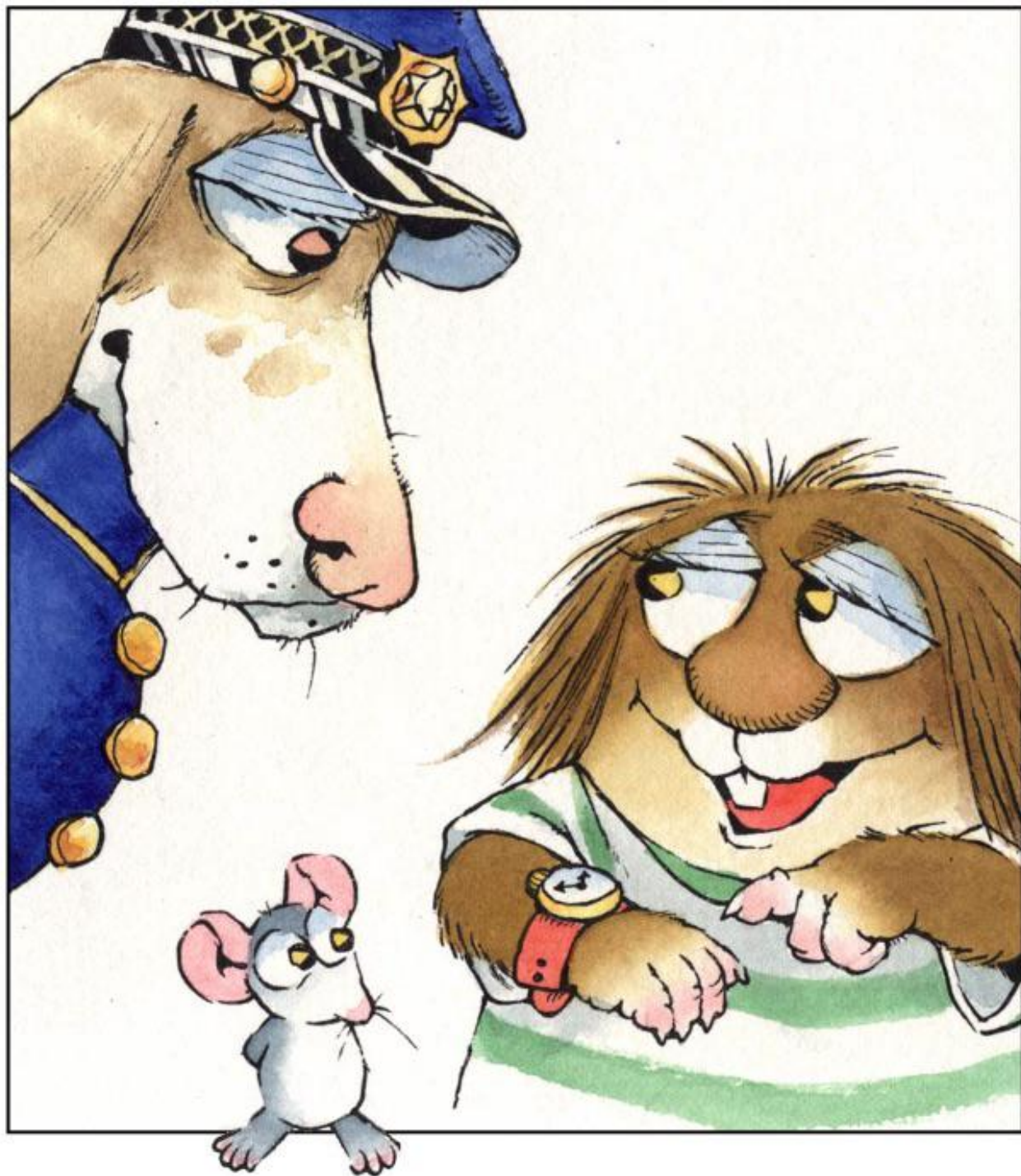


...and spend my allowance
on anything I want.



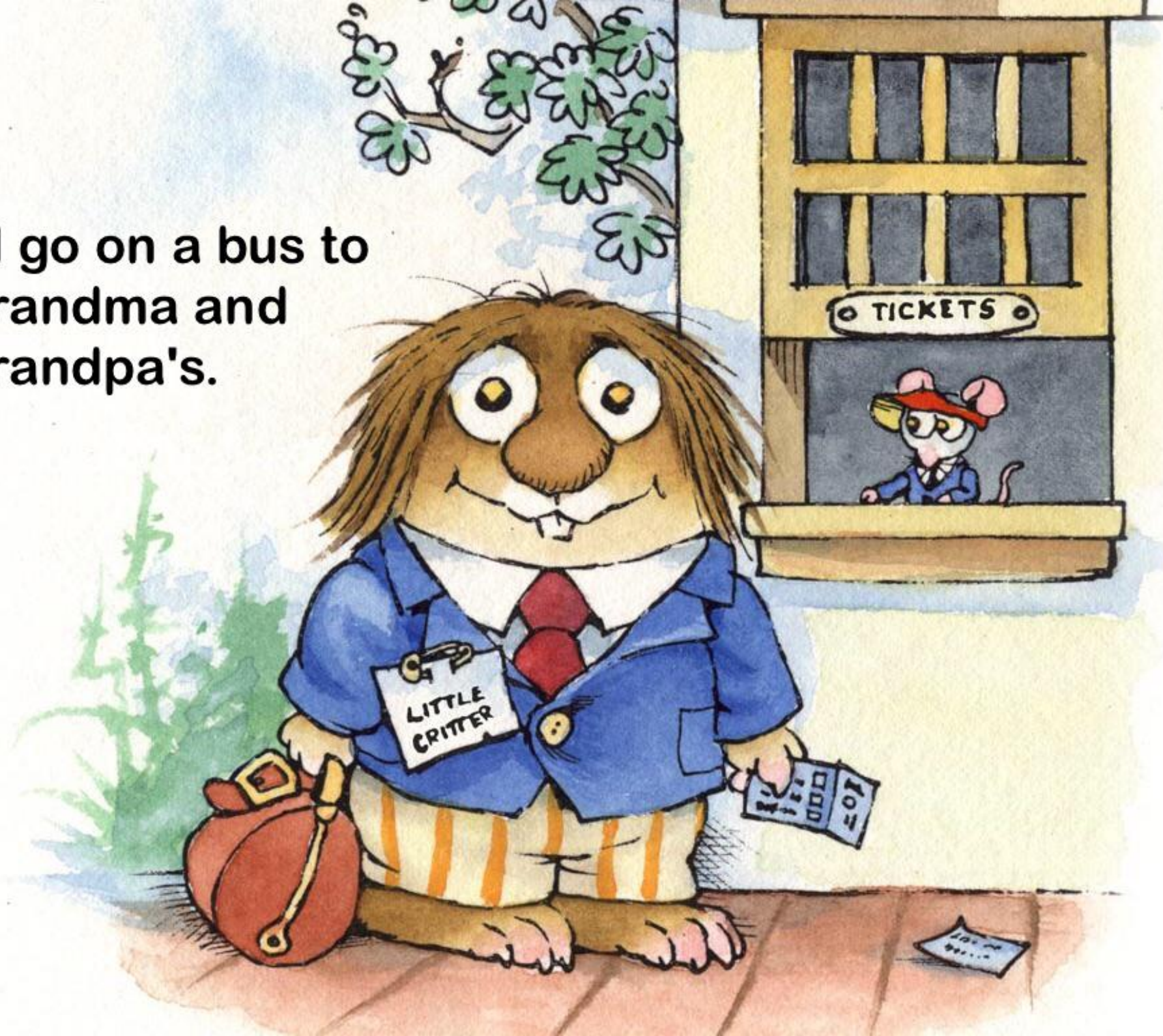
I'll wait until the light is green. Then I'll look both ways for cars before I cross the street.



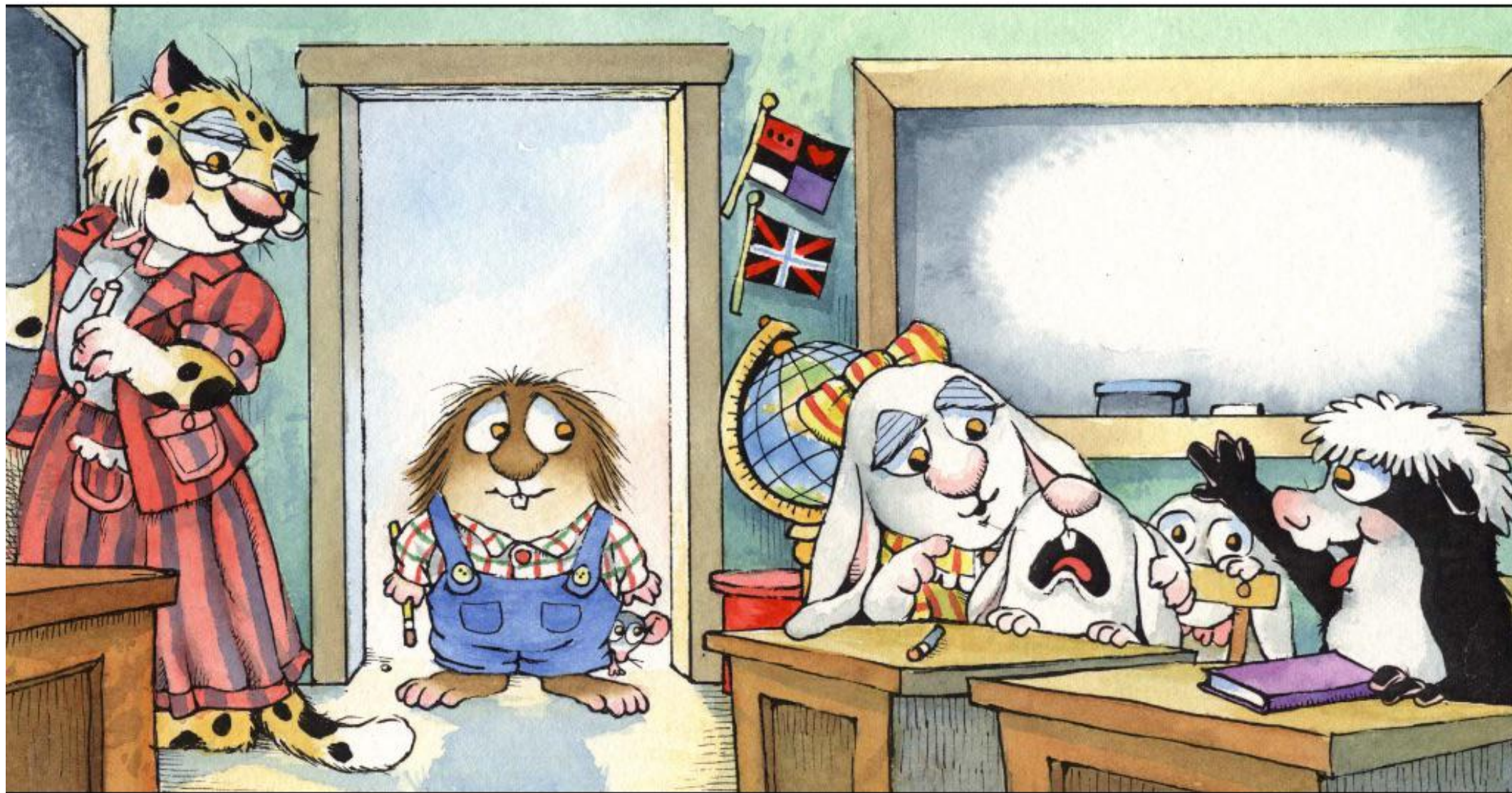


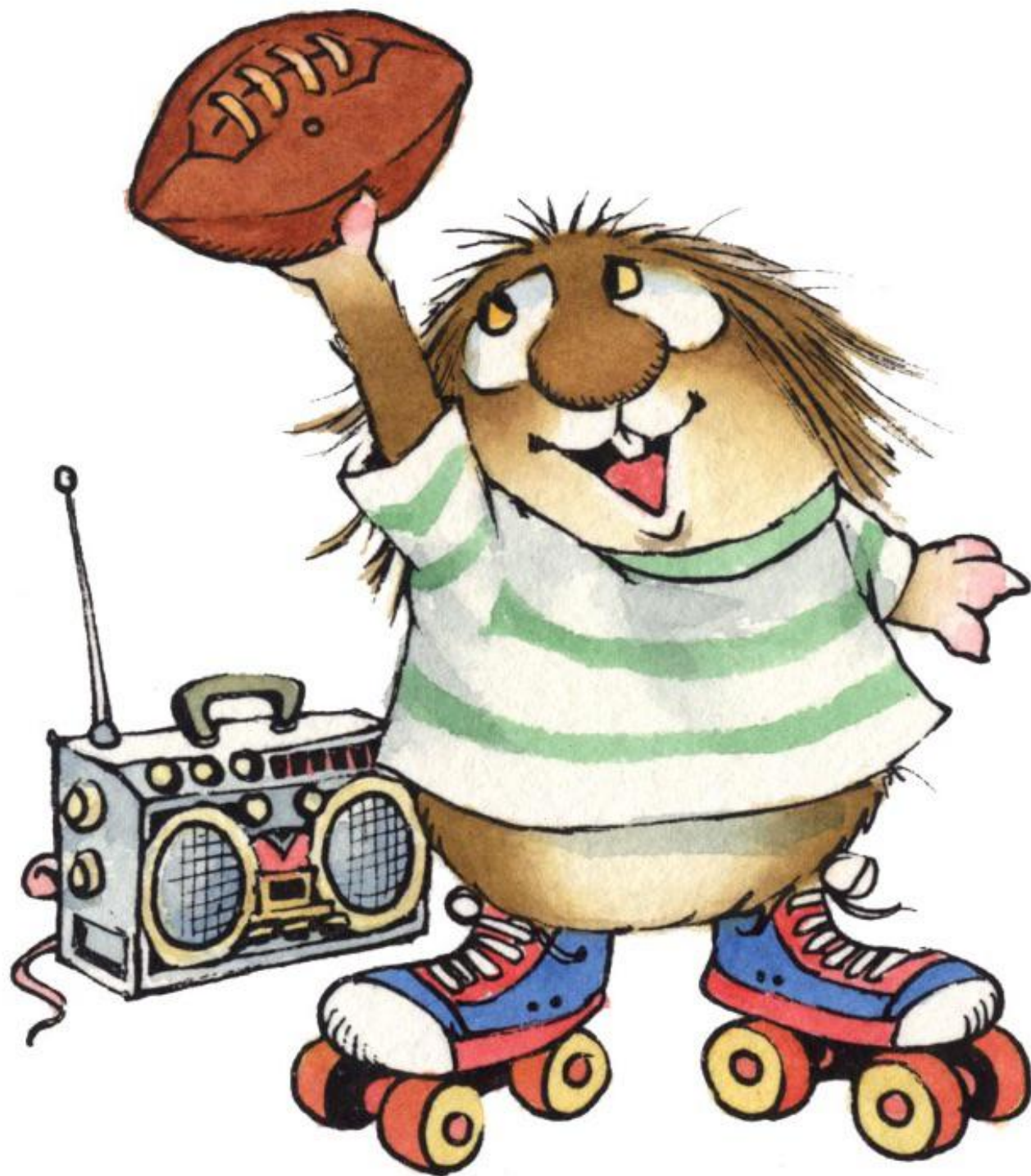

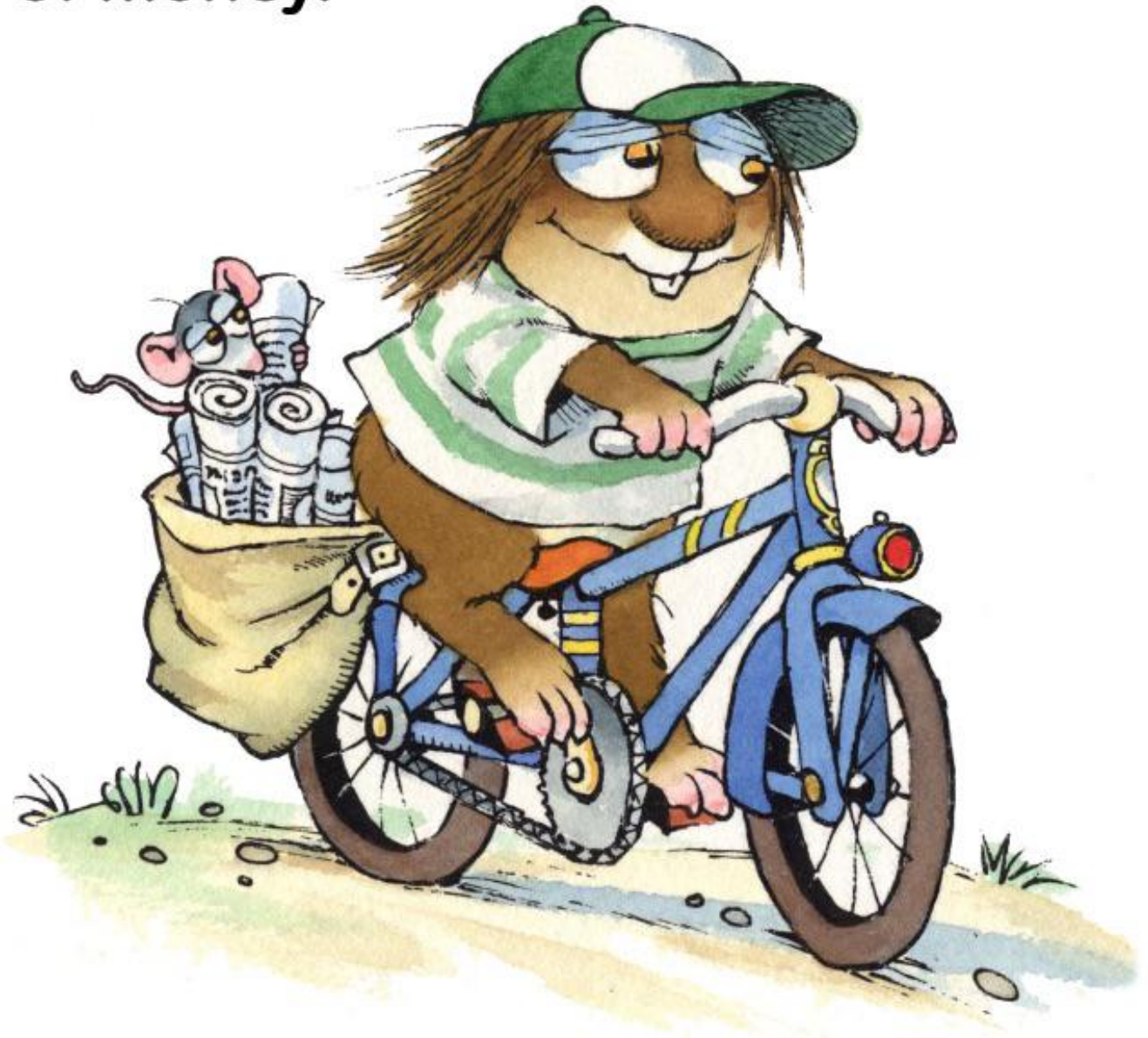


When I get bigger

roller skates.



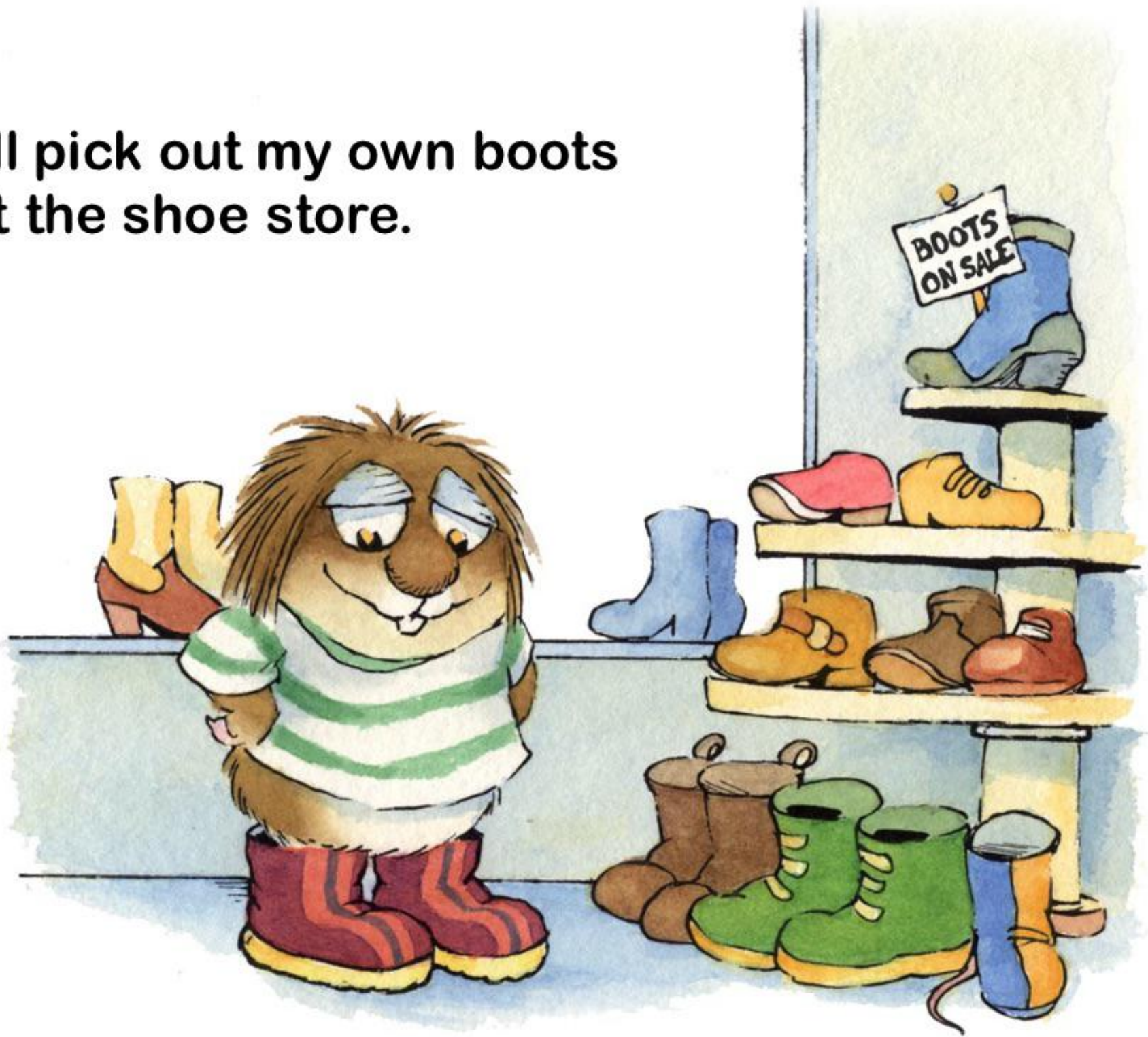
I'll have a two-wheeler and a paper route.

the little kids on the swings.**

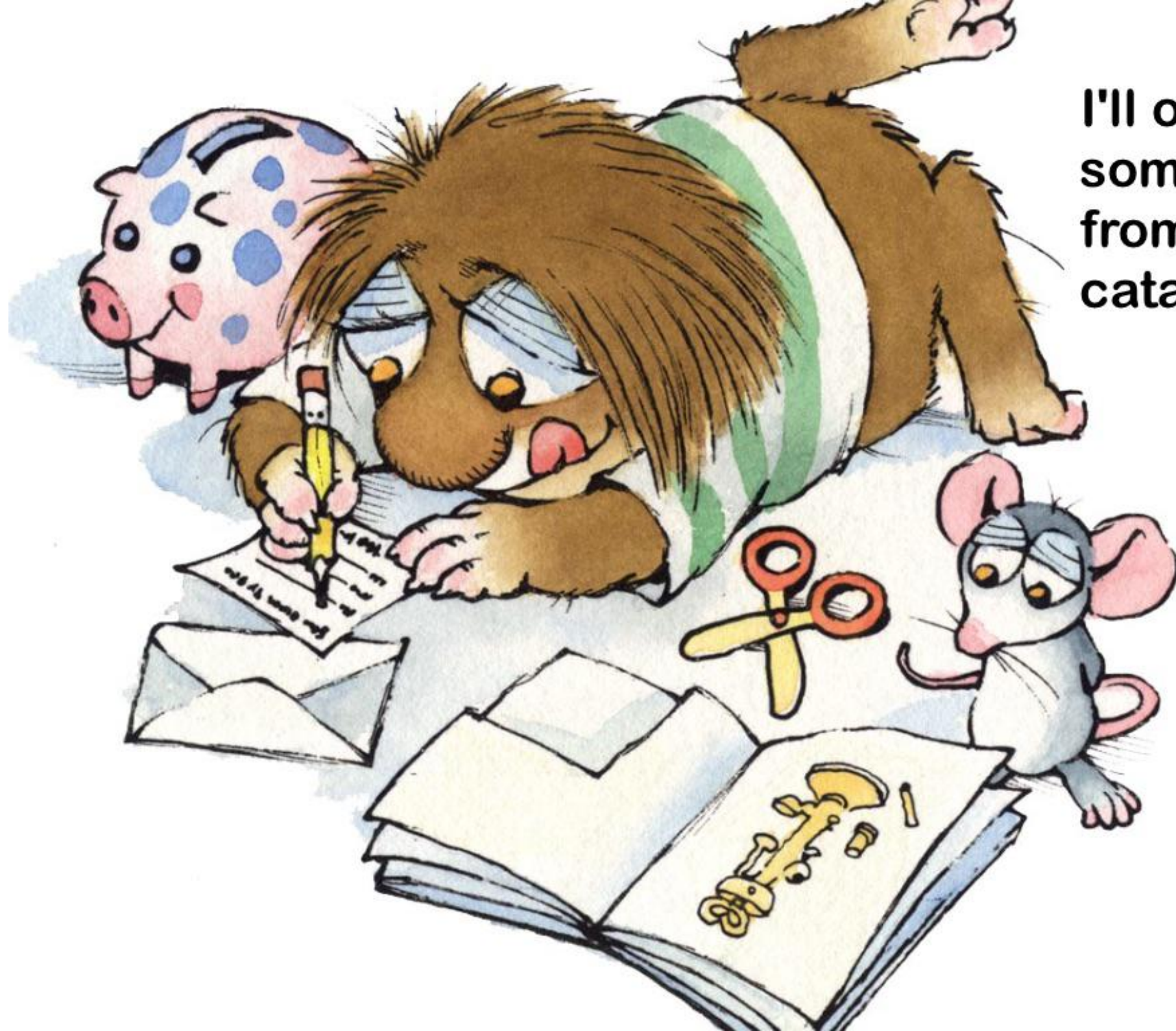


I'll pick out my own boots
at the shoe store.



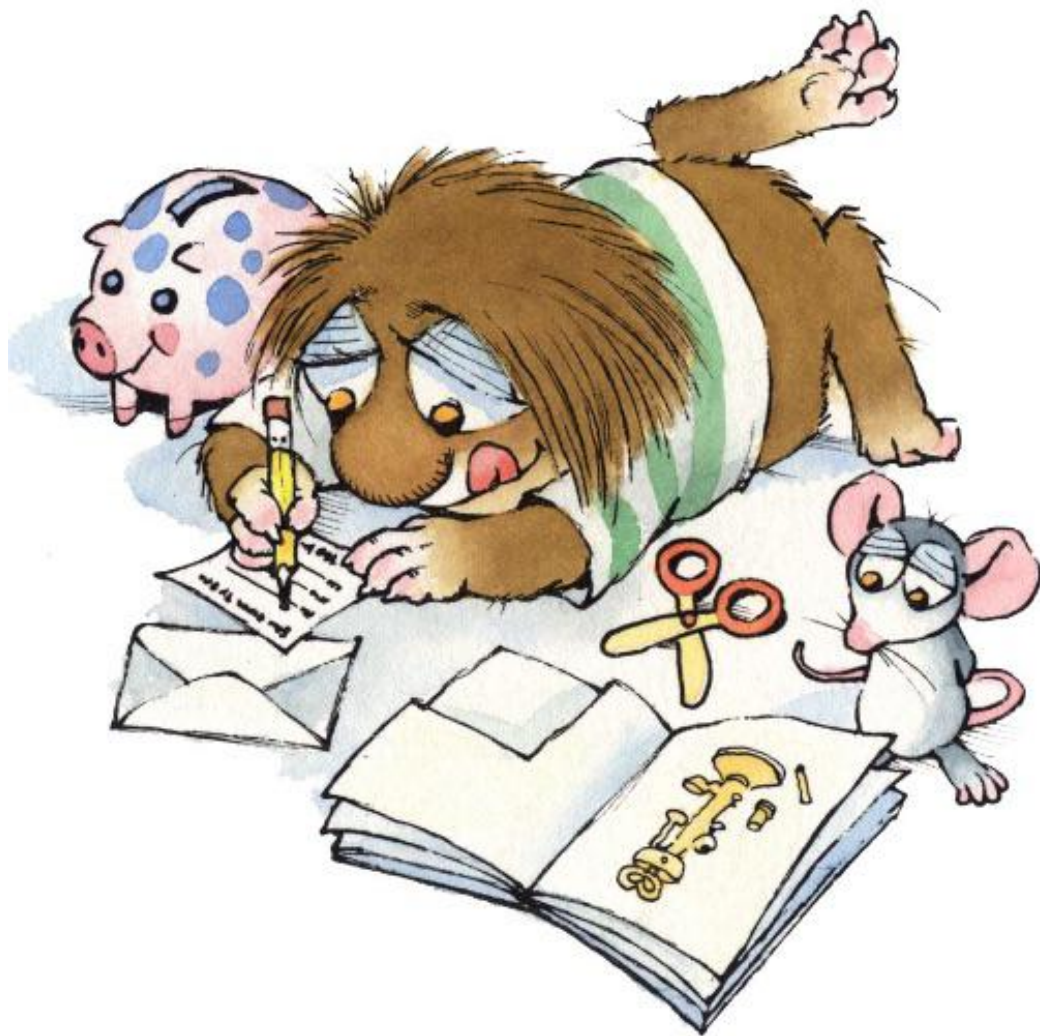
I'll make a phone call and dial it myself.

catalog...

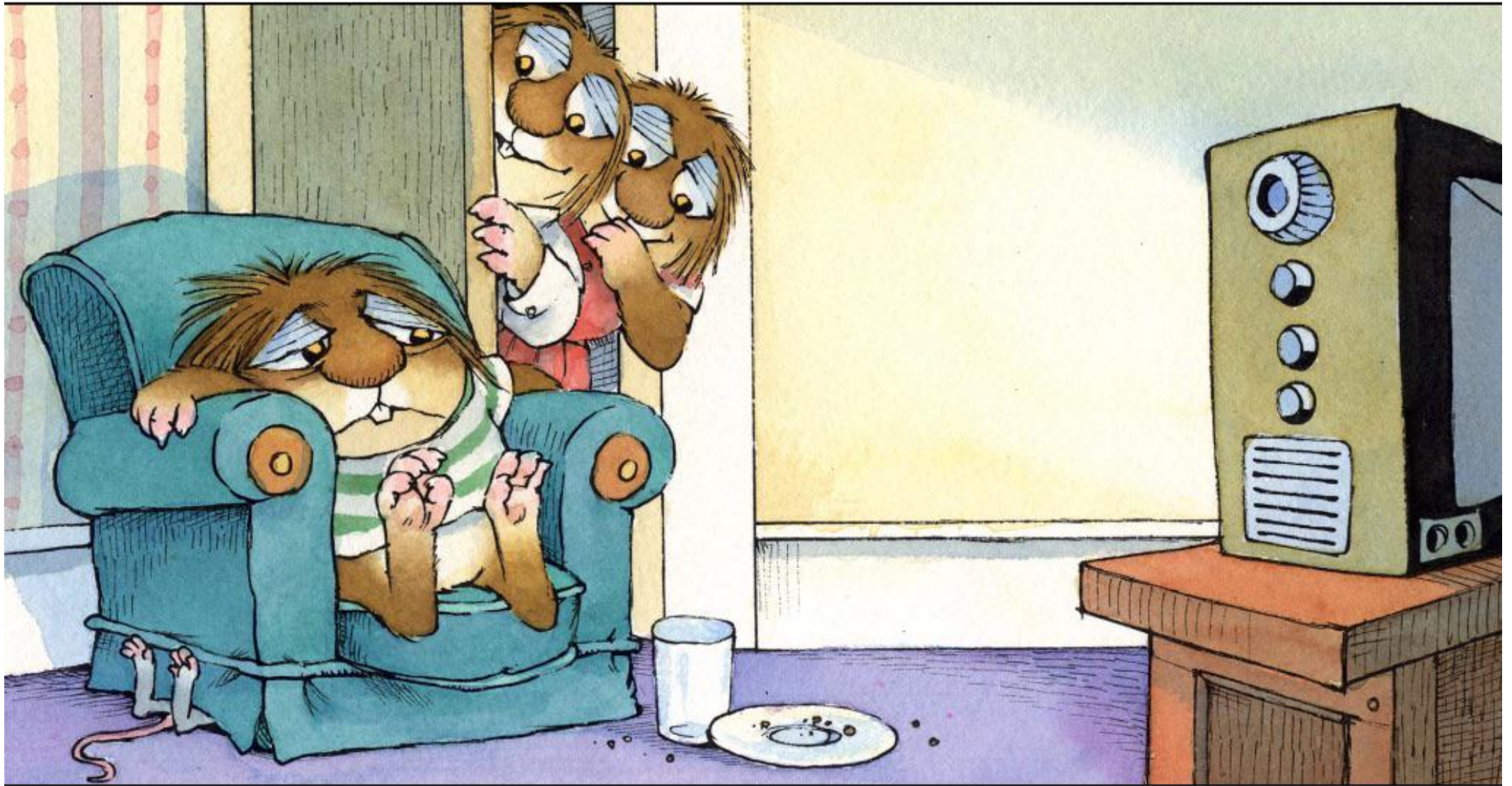
...and it will come in the mail.
