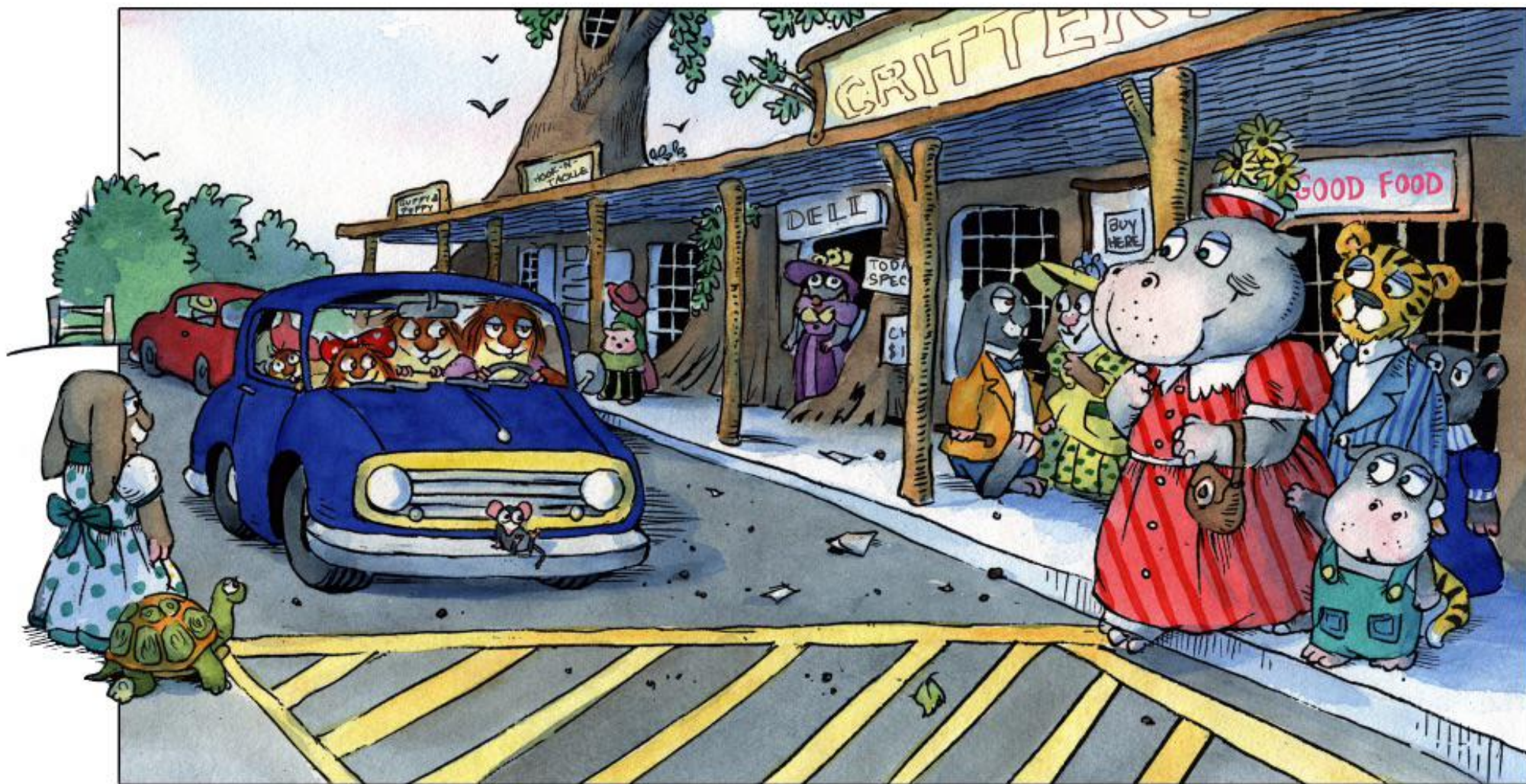


We went shopping.

but not too heavy.



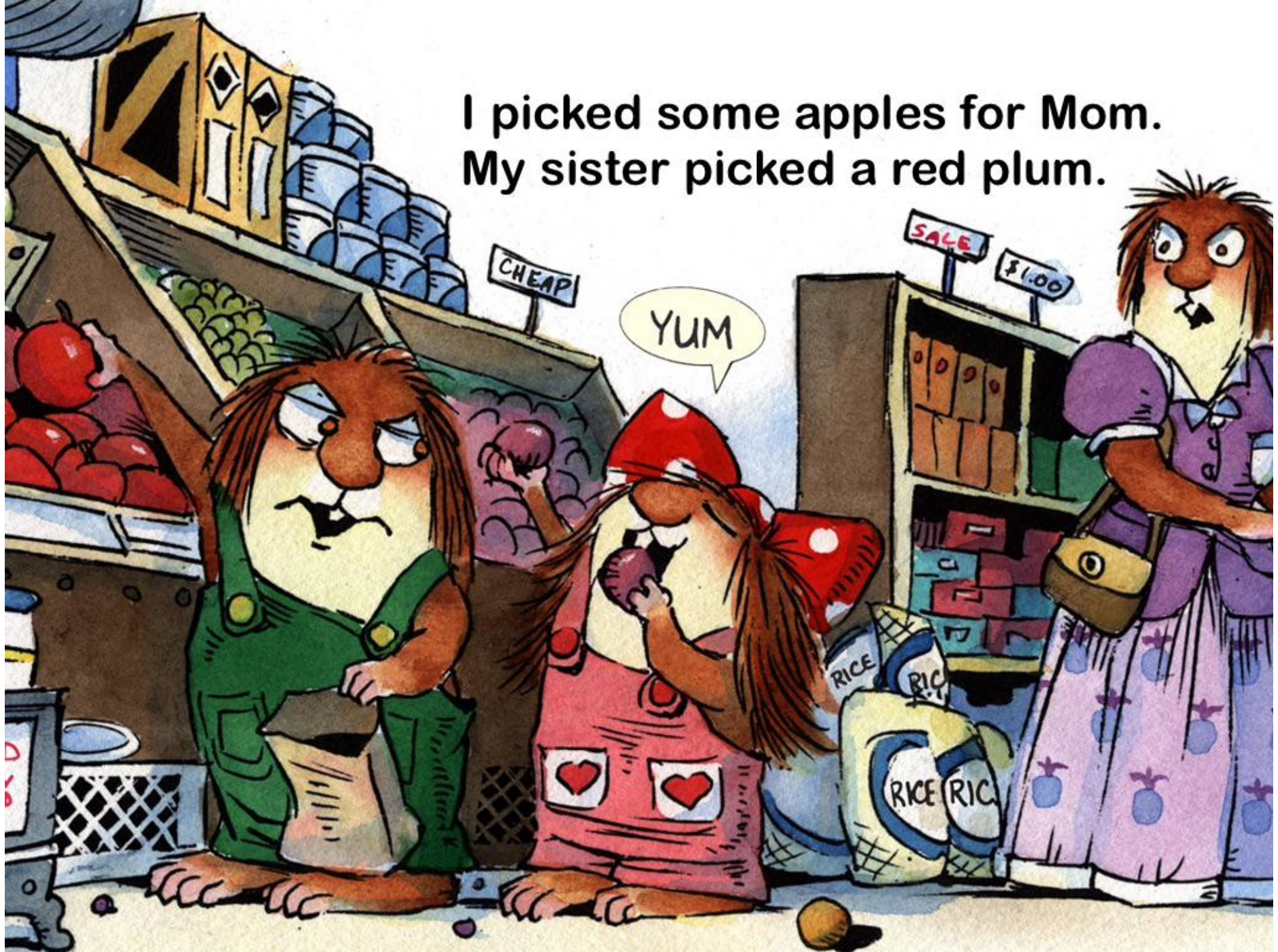
“I want to ride,” said my little sister.

the cart was very heavy.

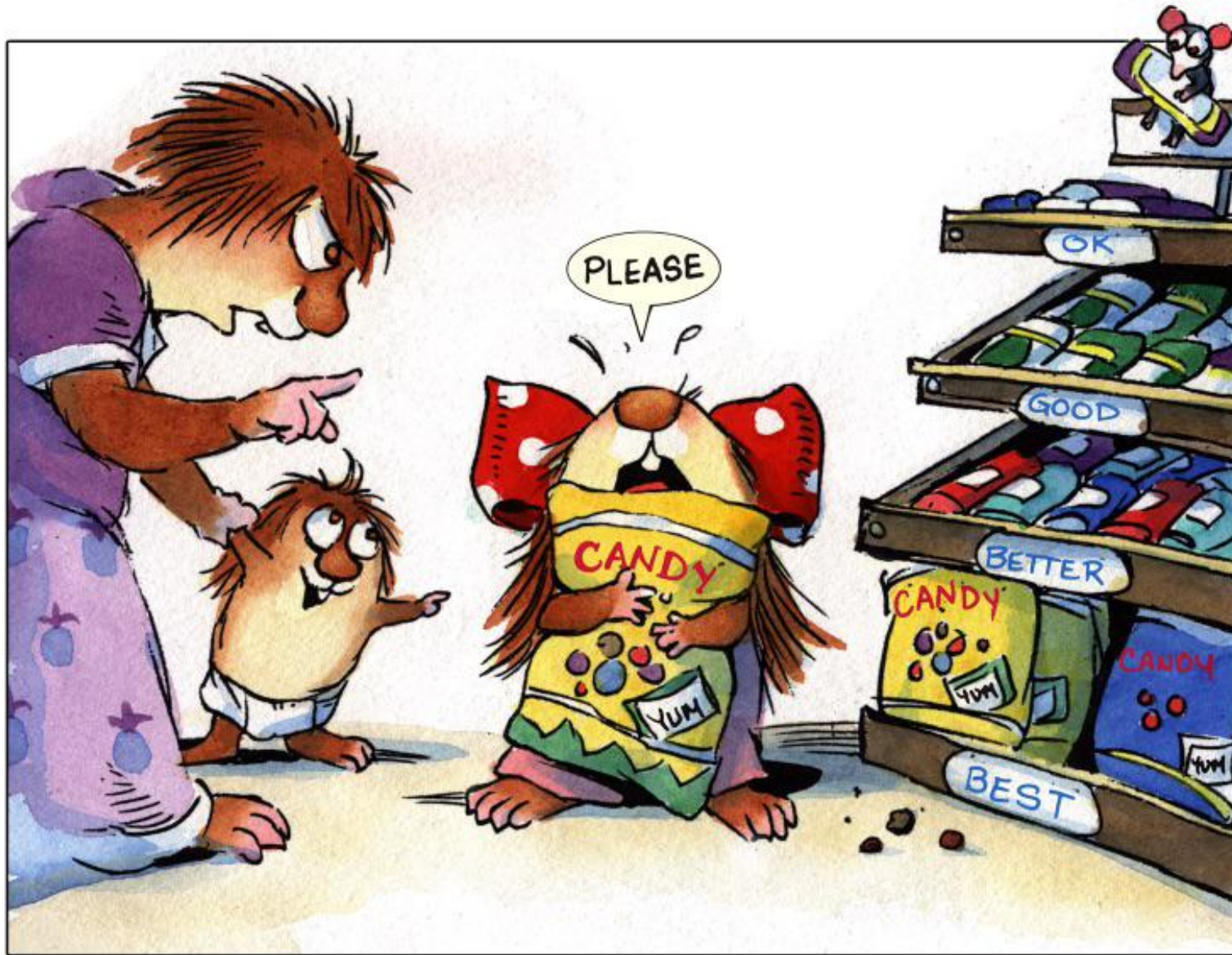


I picked some apples for Mom.

Mom said, "Not today."**

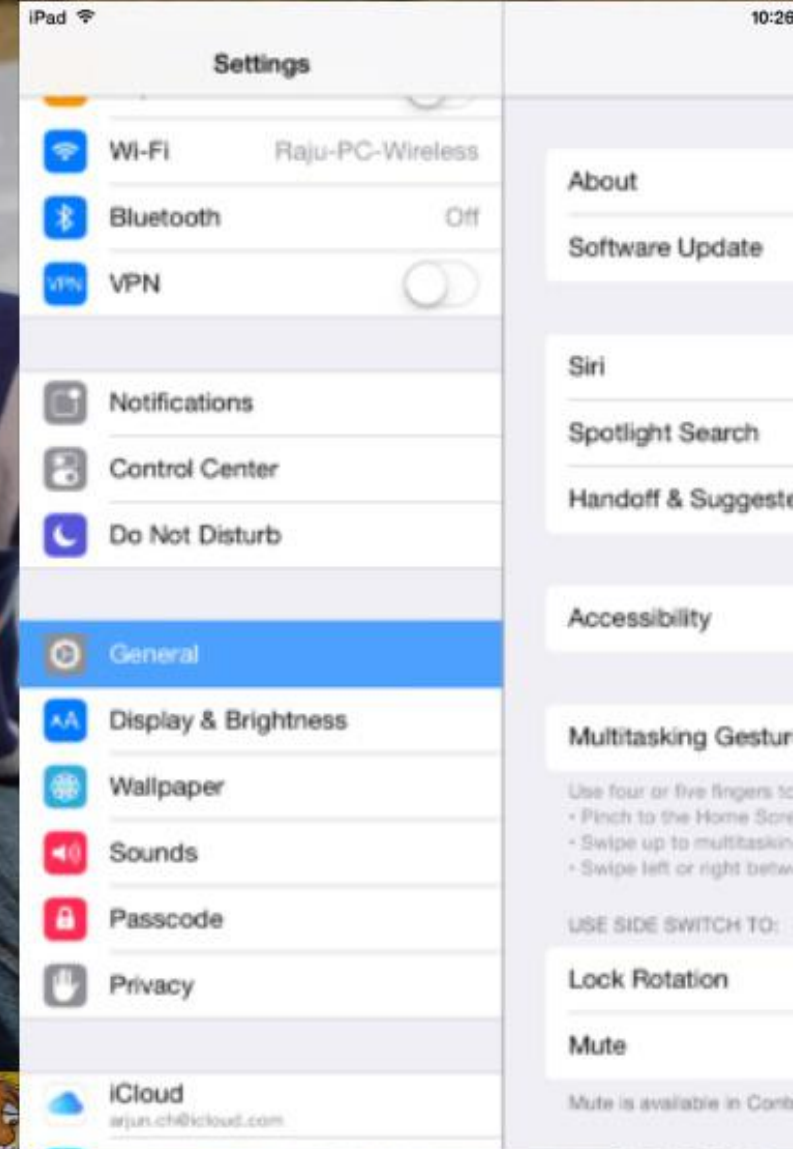
Mom said, "Stay here.

I think she was mad.



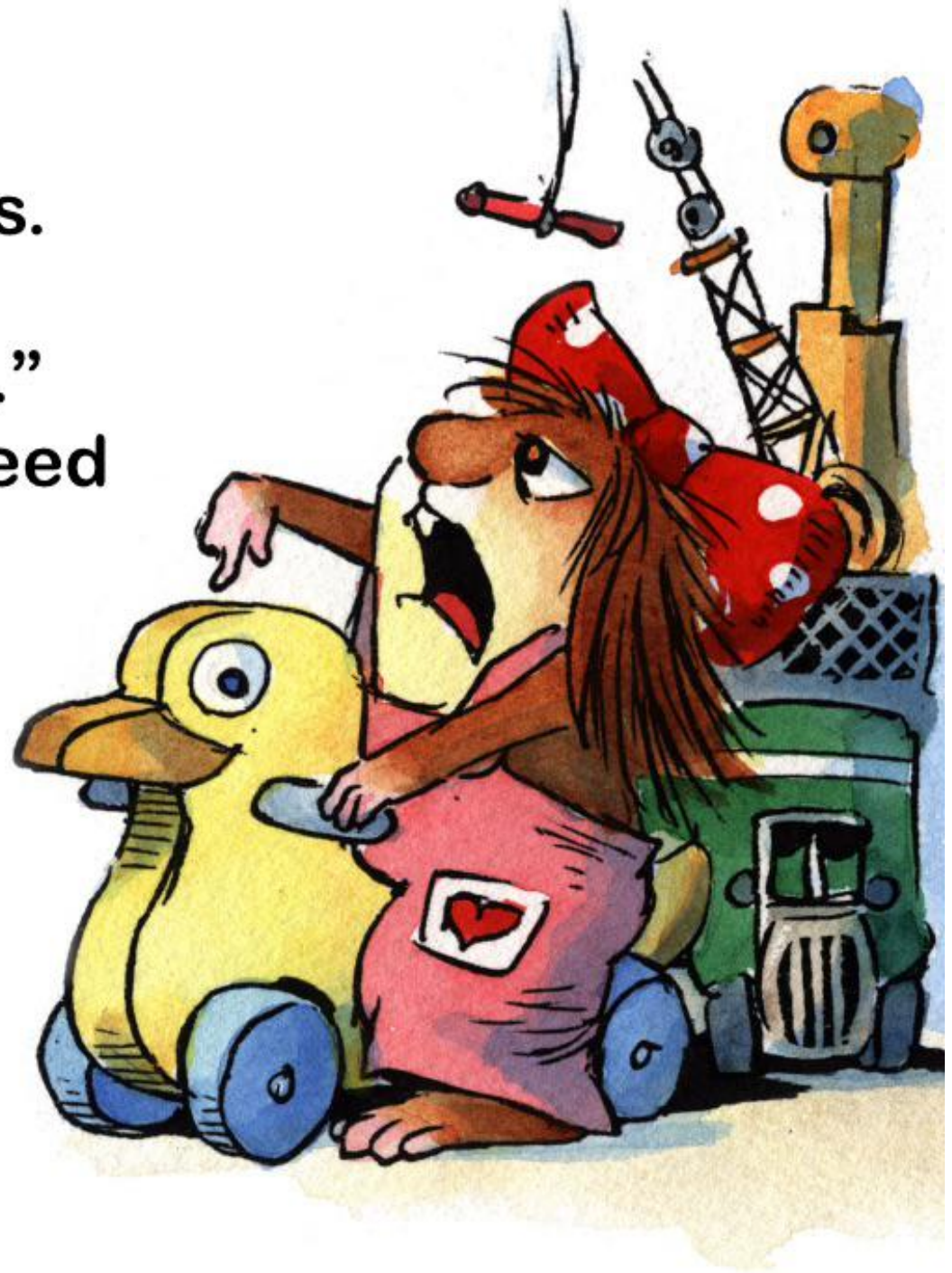
My little sister said, "I want candy."

“Not today,” said Mom.

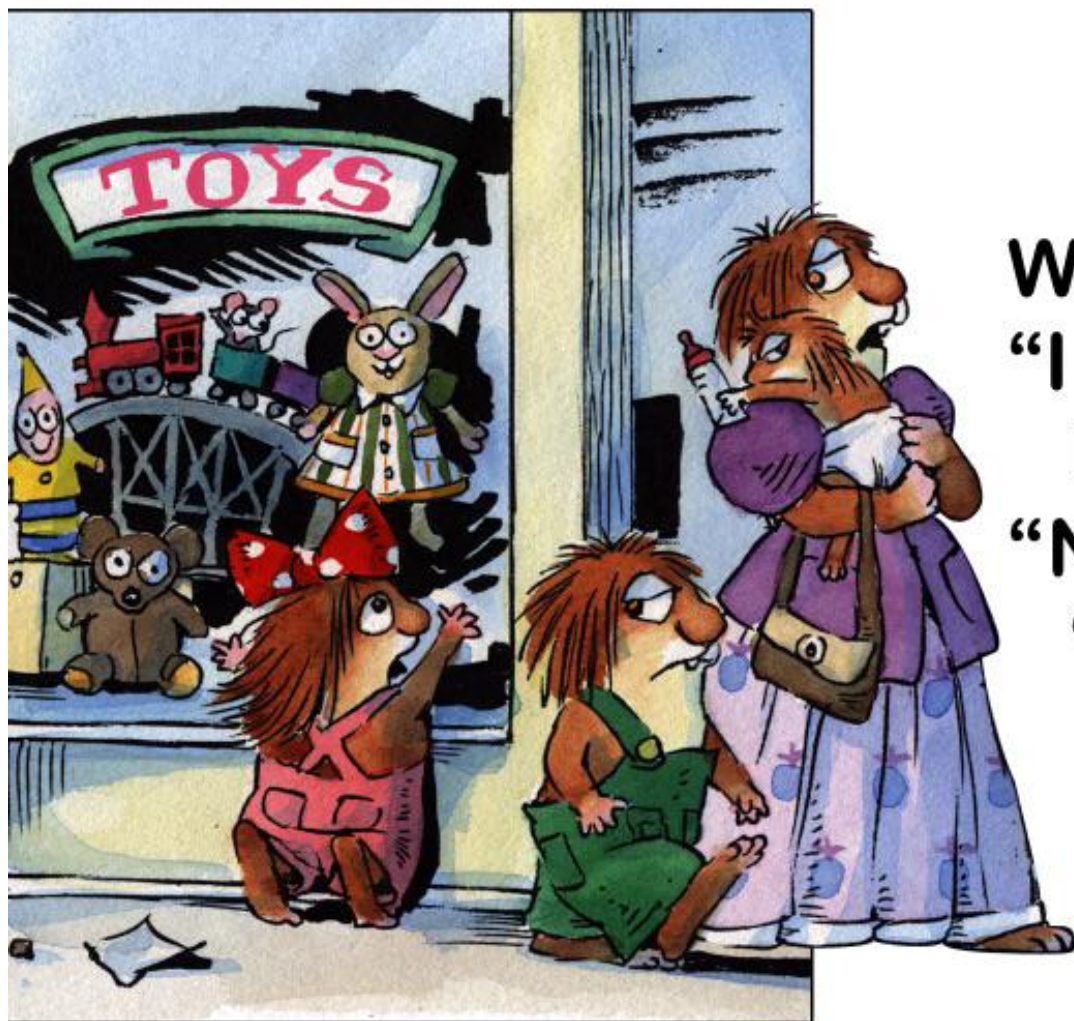




We passed by
