He repeated the lesson for the class.



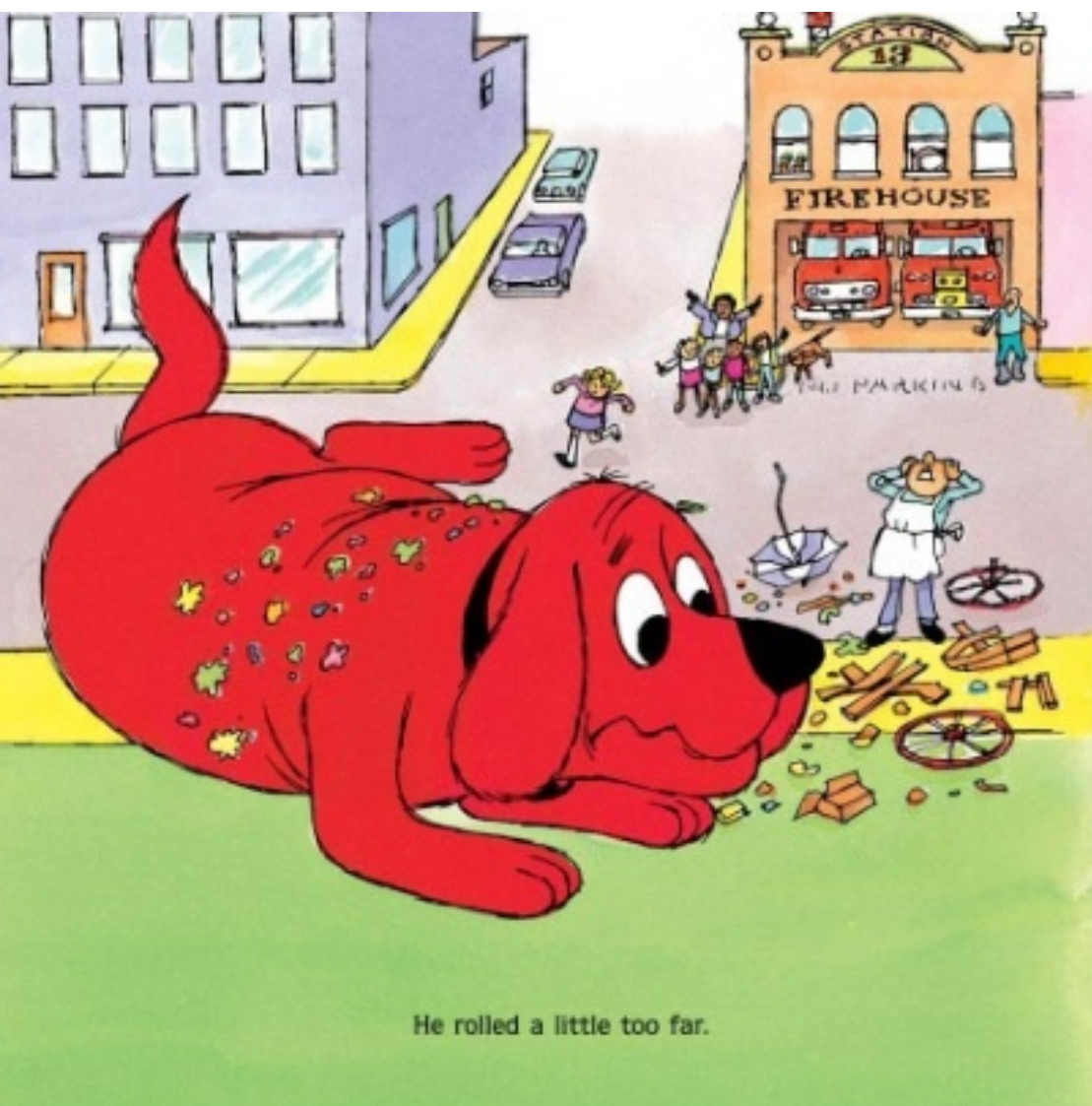
He stopped.

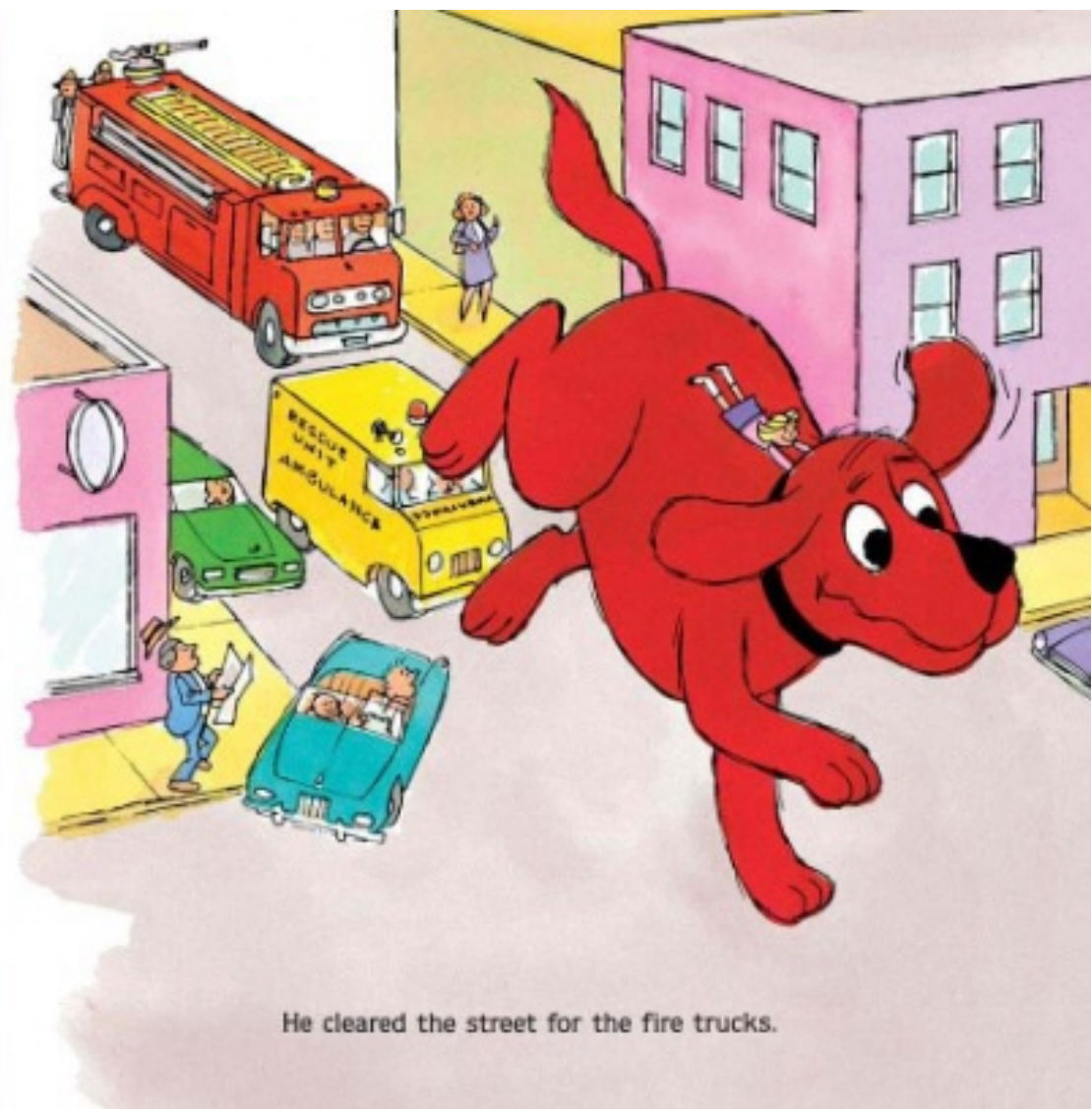


He dropped.

He saw some people in trouble.

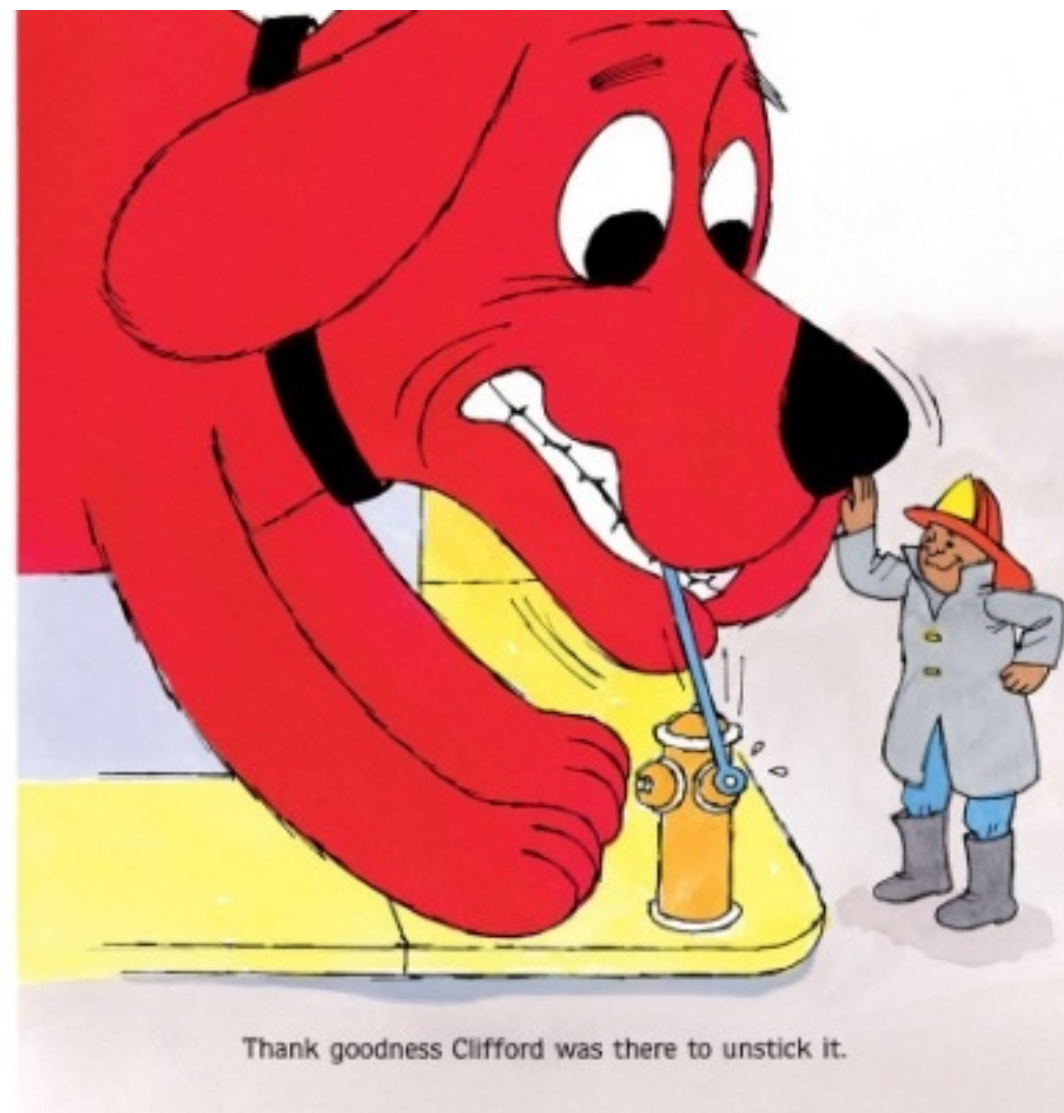




Clifford to the rescue!

The firefighters were calling for more water.

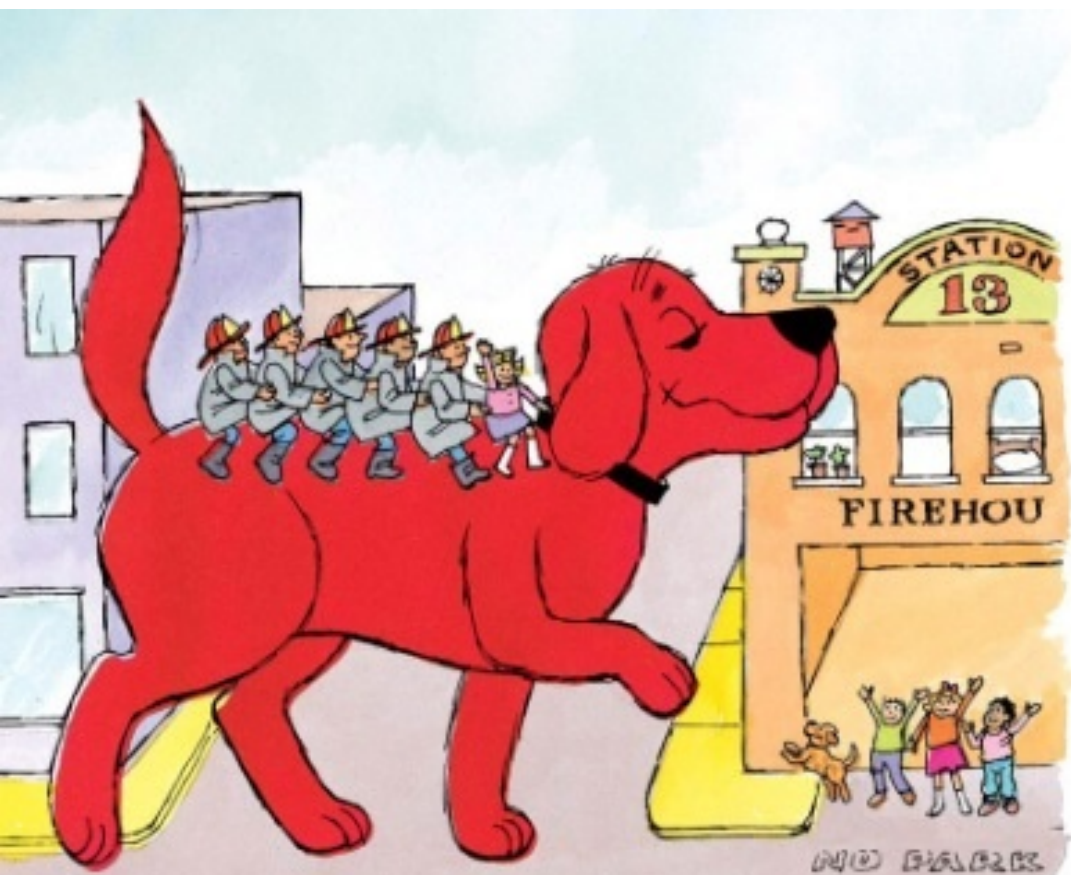


When the fire was out, Clifford made sure that the firefighters got out of the building safely.



They were grateful for everything he had done to help.

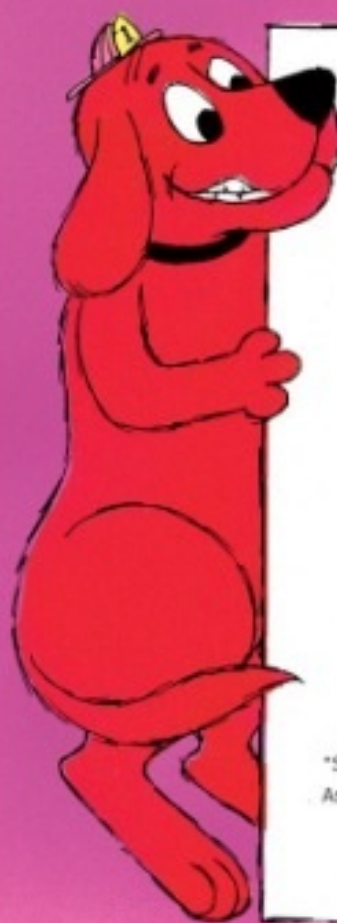




We gave some firefighters a ride back to the firehouse.

7. Never use the stove without an adult.

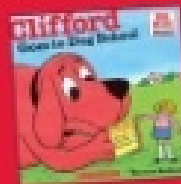
*Some phones can be programmed to dial the Fire Department for you.
Ask your parents if your phone is programmed and how it works.



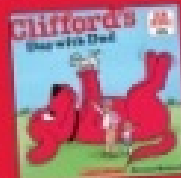
