
INSTRUCTIONS: Color these circles and cut them out to use as chips, or grab a marker and cross them out as you go.

Cut out the game pieces below, mix them up and place them face down on the floor.


Begin the game by turning one piece over, then another. If they match, put them in a pile.

If they don't match, turn both pieces over and try again. Repeat until you've made all 8 matches.










THANKSGIVING MEMORY MATCH



Please note: Game pieces work best when printed on thicker paper.


HONTOPLAY

- 1. Cut out the cards with the help of a parent.
- 2. Mix up the cards and lay them face down on the table.
- 3. The first player turns over two cards to see if they match.
- 4. If the cards match, the player keeps the cards and gets another turn.
- 5. If they do not match, the player turns the cards face down again in the same location and the next player gets his turn to play.
- 6. The player with the most matches in the end, wins!

Ask your child to read aloud all the words with the help of the pictures. Then cut the puzzle pieces from the bottom of the page and ask your child to place it next to its rhyming word.




